

"They fell down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh."



FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As the new year begins, we are excited to unveil a new fundraiser for Queen of All Saints Parish. On January 30th, QAS will inaugurate the QUEEN OF HEARTS RAFFLE. This has been a very popular and successful fundraising event for many churches and civic organizations. It gained notoriety several years ago in the town of Waterloo, Illinois when the jackpot surged to over a million dollars. Last January, a 2-million-dollar jackpot was awarded to one lucky winner in that same town. The raffle there is run by the Catholic Parish of St. Peter and Paul in support of their elementary school.



At Queen of All Saints, drawings will be held on Tuesdays at 8pm beginning January 30th and will continue throughout the year. Tickets are \$5 a piece or 6 for \$25 and will be sold weekly. We are using a third-party company to manage the drawing for us. One name will be drawn electronically each week, and that person will have a chance to select a card from a virtual card display. If the Queen of Hearts is chosen, the winner will receive half of the jackpot and the other half will go to Queen of All Saints Parish. There are also minor prizes for other cards that might be drawn. If the Queen of Hearts card is not drawn, the prize money will roll over to the next drawing and continue to grow. The official rules will be published soon. You may purchase your weekly raffle tickets on-line and for those who might be technologically challenged, assistance will be available after Mass on Sundays and at the rectory during the week. Invite your friends and extended family members to participate and join the fun.



KofC ROSES FOR LIFE










