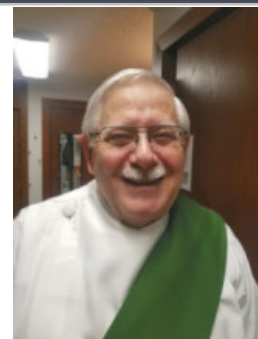
FROM OUR PASTOR

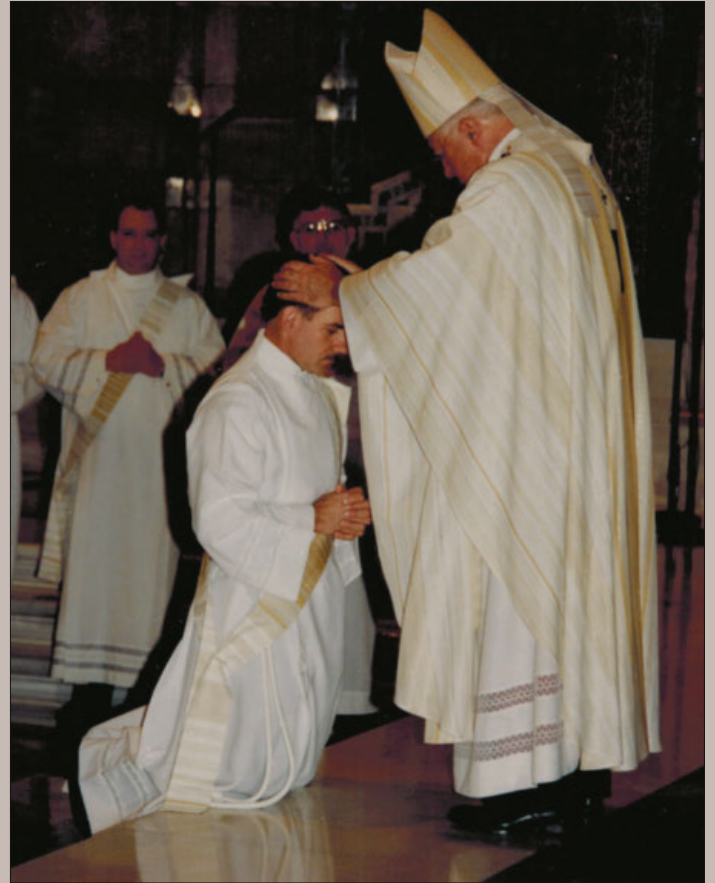

What is ACTS?

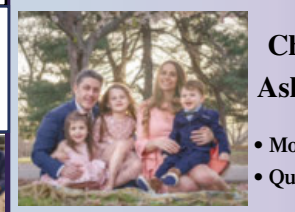
