And so, I would like to officially welcome Deacon Kurt Loeffler and his wife, Barb, to our parish. As mentioned last week, Deacon Loeffler and his wife have lived within our parish boundaries for years and already know many of you. We are blessed to have three wonderful deacons working in our parish with two more in training!



Say What?

Is your ability to hear diminishing? Do you have difficulty hearing the readings, homilies and prayers at Mass? Several parishioners have approached me since my arrival asking if we still have the hearing devices that were once available in church. I'm happy to announce that we have purchased several new hearing devices, and they are available for use at Mass. These devices are NOT like hearing aids. Hearing aids pick up and amplify all the ambient noise around the device. These new devices are tuned directly into the sound system in church. It's like having a church speaker right in your ear. You control the volume to whatever level you want. If you are concerned about using "public" headphones, you can bring your own earpiece and plug it into the device. It has a standard 1/8-inch ear jack. Also, you will be able to purchase your own device if you would like. The estimated cost is around \$150 per device. Now there will be no excuse for reading the bulletin during my homilies!






WHITE HOUSE RETREAT






