What's The Game Plan?

The adventure of Lent is upon us, it begins with Ash Wednesday which is on February 14th this year. Lent is the time designated by the Church for some spiritual Spring cleaning. What is it that is not right in our lives, what needs to change for us to be more fully disciples of Jesus Christ? Throughout the year we get sloppy with our faith, we develop some rough edges. I invite you to do some spiritual inventory, examen your conscience. Do not enter the season of Lent without a game plan. There are special graces from God made available to those who sincerely seek to repent from

sin and seek virtue. Make use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, find time for some spiritual reading and prayer every day, identify the vices in life that need to go. Lent is an adventure. Keep it simple and be consistent. God's grace is here for us!

Masses are scheduled on Ash Wednesday at 6:15am, 8:15am, 10am (Children's Mass) and 7pm. Ashes will be distributed at each Mass after the homily. As Catholics we are called to fast and abstain from meat as a sign of penance.



Throughout the season of Lent, we invite you to bring the palms that you received last year on Palm Sunday and leave them in the Church gathering area. Hopefully there will be a container there to put them in. We will use these palms at the Easter Vigil to light the Easter fire at the beginning of the vigil.




