Keep it simple and be consistent. God's grace is here for us!

Masses are scheduled on Ash Wednesday at 6:15am, 8:15am, 10am (Children's Mass) and 7pm. Ashes will be distributed at each Mass after the homily. As Catholics we are called to fast and abstain from meat as a sign of penance.

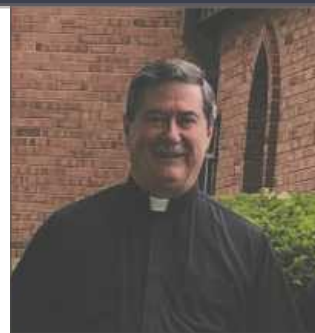
Bring Your Old Palm Branches
