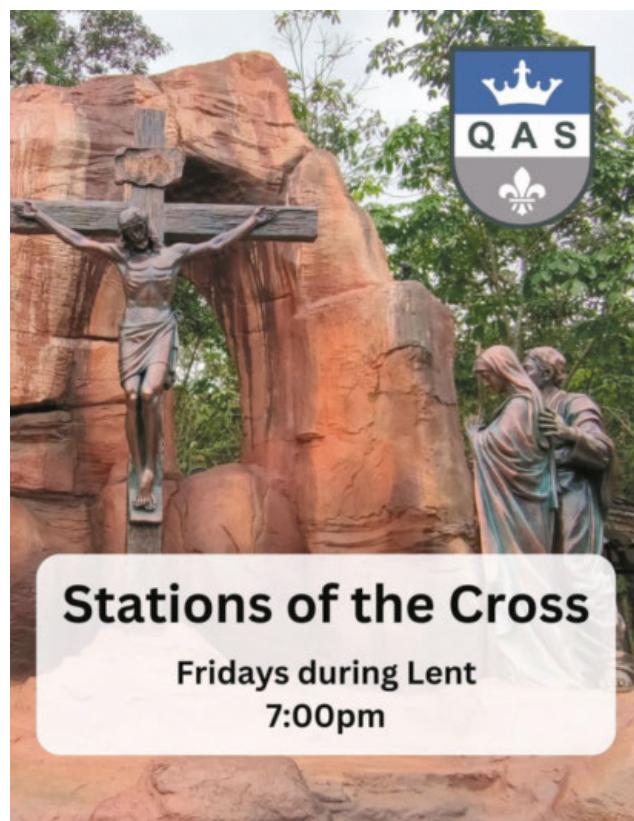

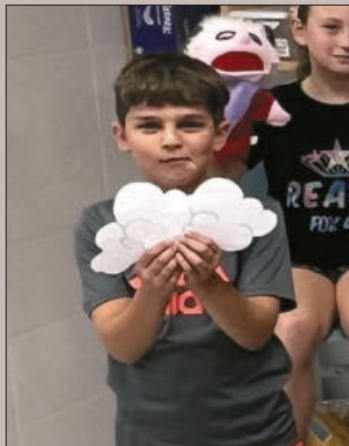

Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, **you will need your User name and Password**. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding.
