**STEWARDSHIP
1ST SUNDAY OF LENT**

"It is written: 'The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve.'" *MATTHEW 4:10*

Tempted between the riches and power of this world and service to God, Jesus chose service to His Father. If we wish to truly follow Jesus, we, too, must decide to turn away from worldly power and riches and put God at the center of our lives. Lent is our time to prune ourselves of earthly things, and develop and nurture heavenly things. Lent is time to repent and let go of the other "gods" we have put before God.

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Those of you who go to Confession and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation will notice a slight change in the words of absolution spoken by the priest to effect the removal of sins. Last year the Vatican's Congregation for Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments issued a revised translation for the Order of Penance. Always striving to have the best translation of the original Latin text, the Congregation focused on two Latin words and declared that a change in translation would communicate better the

fullness of the prayer.

Fr. Nicholas Smith, Director of the Archdiocesan Office of Sacred Worship explains the changes thus: In the former translation the priest prayed "has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins...." The key Latin words are "*Spiritus Sanctum effudit.*" *Effudit* is the same word used in the Latin Bible when describing the action of Mary of Bethany as she "poured out," (*effudit*) perfumed oil on the feet of Jesus. This gesture of Mary - pouring out - was more than what was the expected sign of hospitality. In a similar way, the mercy of God given by the power of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a rich outpouring of the unmerited love of God for our salvation. In the Gospel episode (John 12:1-8), the disciples are amazed at the woman's extravagant generosity and Judas Iscariot even complains that it is too much. Likewise, in Confession, God is extravagant in his mercy as he pours out the Holy Spirit, though we never complain about that. Henceforth, then the priest will say "...**poured out the Holy Spirit** for the forgiveness of sins..."

Secondly, there is another line from the absolution prayer that went, "...may God give you pardon and peace..." The Latin has the word *tribuat*, which is better translated as "grant," rather than "give." Using "grant," it was felt, speaks more clearly to God's generosity and willingness to share all good things with his people.

These new words went into effect on Ash Wednesday and are required to be used, at the latest, by Divine Mercy Sunday (April 16). However, if a priest (for example, an old guy like me) accidentally slips back into the old translation, don't worry, your sins will be forgiven, for the most crucial words are "I absolve you in the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." We won't forget those words.

Many of you don't go to Confession and you don't take your children there, either. Now is the time to change that. We have begun the Season of Lent, which the Church recognizes as God's "gracious gift each year" (Preface I), and as a "sacred time for the renewing and purifying of their hearts" (Preface II). This beautiful sacrament enables that purification, that removal of the junk that messes up our lives.

Thomas "Tip" O'Neal was a U.S. Representative to Congress and Speaker of the House from 1977-1987. He loved to tell the story of a character from his hometown of Boston called Honest Jake. Jake was well known in the Boston area because of his assistance to three generations of immigrant families. He owned a little variety store and would extend credit to poor immigrants to help them get started in their new home. As Honest Jake neared his 60th birthday, a group of people he had helped decided to give him a party, and a generous gift of a lot of money.

Honest Jake received the money gratefully and began to use it for his own makeover. He had his teeth capped. He bought a hairpiece. He invested in a diet and exercise program and lost a lot of weight. He bought new clothes. Tired of Boston winters, he flew to Miami and soaked in the sun on the beach. He met a pretty girl, liked her a lot, and was thrilled when she accepted his invitation to go on a date. He was so excited, then devastated when he was struck by lightning and killed instantly.

In Heaven, Jake protested to God, "After all those years of hard work, I was just starting to enjoy myself a little. Why? Why me? Why now?" And God said to him, "Honest Jake, is that you? I'm sorry. I didn't recognize you."

Lent is our time for God to recognize us. Not the person who sins, who purposely turns away from God or who covers our true self with deceit, gossip, apathy, greed, or self-righteousness. That's not who we are. That's not the disciple God calls us to be. Now is the sacred time for purification, whereby God will recognize us as the prayerful, charitable, and obedient people God wants us to be. This recognition occurs when God pours out the power of the Holy Spirit and generously grants us pardon and peace. Therefore, go to Confession. Be amazed at the generous mercy of God.

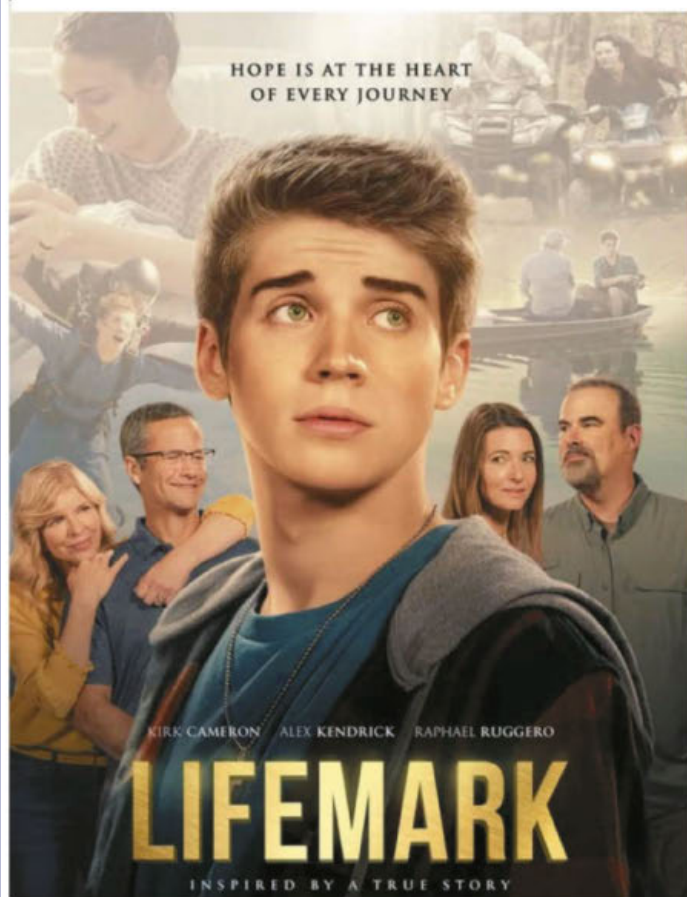
SALAD DONATIONS NEEDED FOR ST. PATRICK CENTER

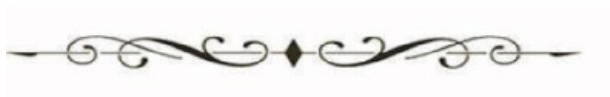
