

Informational Meeting on the Missouri Abortion Ballot Initiative, March 18
Through May 5, abortion supporters are actively collecting signatures throughout
Missouri for a ballot measure to attempt to insert abortion into the state constitution. To
help educate the faithful and parishes on this ballot initiative, the Respect Life
Apostolate and Southern Vicariate are hosting an informational meeting on Monday,
March 18 at Ste. Genevieve Parish in Ste. Genevieve, MO 63670. It will take place in
the DuBourg Centre at 305 Merchant St. Starting at 6:30 p.m., clergy, parish pro-life
coordinators, parish staff, volunteers, and the community are invited to learn best
practices on defeating the initiative from Deacon Sam Lee of Campaign Life Missouri.
Deacon Lee is a veteran pro-life lobbyist in Missouri and serves on the Respect Life
Apostolate Board.



A SPECIAL NOTE FOR MSGR. JOVANOVIC

I am writing something about myself. Some of you may know the whole story, some part of it and others may not know anything. To be honest, I do not know all the details either because I was somewhat out of it. I am telling as I was told by my sister.

Shortly after the first of this year, I was taken to Mercy South Hospital. I was in intensive care for four days. I had eighty monitors on me. I came out of there and to a regular patient room for a couple of weeks. Now, I am back at St. Agnes in the care center.

My condition is quite involved. I have congenital heart failure, bad Kidneys & Liver, and low on Potassium. I am on oxygen and I need a Hoyer lift to get me in or out of bed and the same for my wheelchair.

It is the prayers of all you people that got me where I am today. I am very grateful for them. I am also grateful to my sister and sister-in-law and the rest of my family who took care of me.



A NOTE FOR THE EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS

Dear Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, please remember to purify your Pyx. Especially if you have to fracture a host, there could be small particles left in your Pyx. Put water in your Pyx and consume it so no particles remain.

Also, when bringing the Eucharist to the homebound or sick, bring a small white purificator, which you can get in the sacristy, in case someone spits out part of the host. The residue will need to be put in a cup of water and brought to a Priest or Deacon, who will take it to the sacristy for proper disposition.





You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
