Pew Update

Plans are moving forward to replace our aging pews in church. On the afternoon of Sunday June 9 th, after Sunday Masses have ended, we will begin to remove the pews and prepare for the partial renovation of the church. After the old pews are removed, the ceiling will be painted, the two confessionals will be redesigned and updated, the backdrop behind the baptismal font and stature of Mary will be cleaned up and



repainted, new flooring will be installed and finally the new pews will be installed. We decided to make some upgrades to the quality of the new pews which resulted in increased costs. The Church Renovation Committee has more detailed information about these upgrades in this bulletin. While most of the project is covered by our **Growing in Christ!** capital improvement campaign account from our Beyond Sunday fundraising event several years ago, we still need around \$30,000 to complete the job. If you have been blessed financially by God, please consider contributing to help complete the project.

In the meantime, we plan to celebrate daily masses at 6:15 and 8:15 a.m. in the church basement and Sunday Masses will be celebrated in the school cafeteria until the completion of the project which will hopefully take place in early August. We are still working on tentative plans for handling funerals during the summer. Obviously, no one wants to have a loved one buried from a school cafeteria, so we are looking into several options. Things will certainly get interesting, please be patient. At the end of August we are hoping to have Archbishop Rozanski bless our renovation project and spend some time celebrating with us afterwards.

Breaking Up Is Hard to Do

Our parish receptionist, **Cindi Gerber**, who has been suffering from severe bouts of rheumatoid arthritis for several weeks informed me that she is stepping down from her position here at Queen of All Saints. Besides greeting people with her friendly smile at the door, she also put together the bulletin each week, kept the sacramental books updated, scheduled masses for people and much more. Cindi always found time for people who would drop by for a chat in her office, and she will be missed by many people. Kelly Backer, a QAS parishioner, will be filling in for her and most likely take over her position. I want to thank Cindi for her dedication to the parish and for the kindness she showed to so many people. God bless you!



A NOTE FOR THE EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS

Dear Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, please remember to purify your Pyx. Especially if you have to fracture a host, there could be small particles left in your Pyx. Put water in your Pyx and consume it so no particles remain.

Also, when bringing the Eucharist to the homebound or sick, bring a small white purificator, which you can get in the sacristy, in case someone spits out part of the host. The residue will need to be put in a cup of water and brought to a Priest or Deacon, who will take it to the sacristy for proper disposition.


Do You Like to Golf?

CHURCH RENOVATION UPDATE

We have some exciting news to share with you! The pews have been ordered and we are on track for our summer renovation schedule. In an effort to maximize the beauty, comfort and longevity of our investment, the Church Renovation Committee has chosen to upgrade our pews to solid hardwood in lieu of wood veneer. We feel this will maximize the elegance of our long-term investment. In addition, we have chosen to upgrade the look of the pew frontals (the section in front of the first pew) with raised panel hardware to enhance the look of our worship space. We have also upgraded the pew seat back to a contoured seat to improve comfort. With these upgrades, the cost of the pews has increased by \$29,500. While we continue to execute our renovation with a focus on good stewardship of your donations, we believe this is a valued investment that will be enjoyed for generations. As such, we ask that you prayerfully consider a donation to offset the cost of these upgrades as we would greatly appreciate your generosity. Please recognize that any donation would be restricted to the church renovation project and not used for general parish expenses. ALTARS OF REPOSE THIS THURSDAY


Thursday, February March 28th
