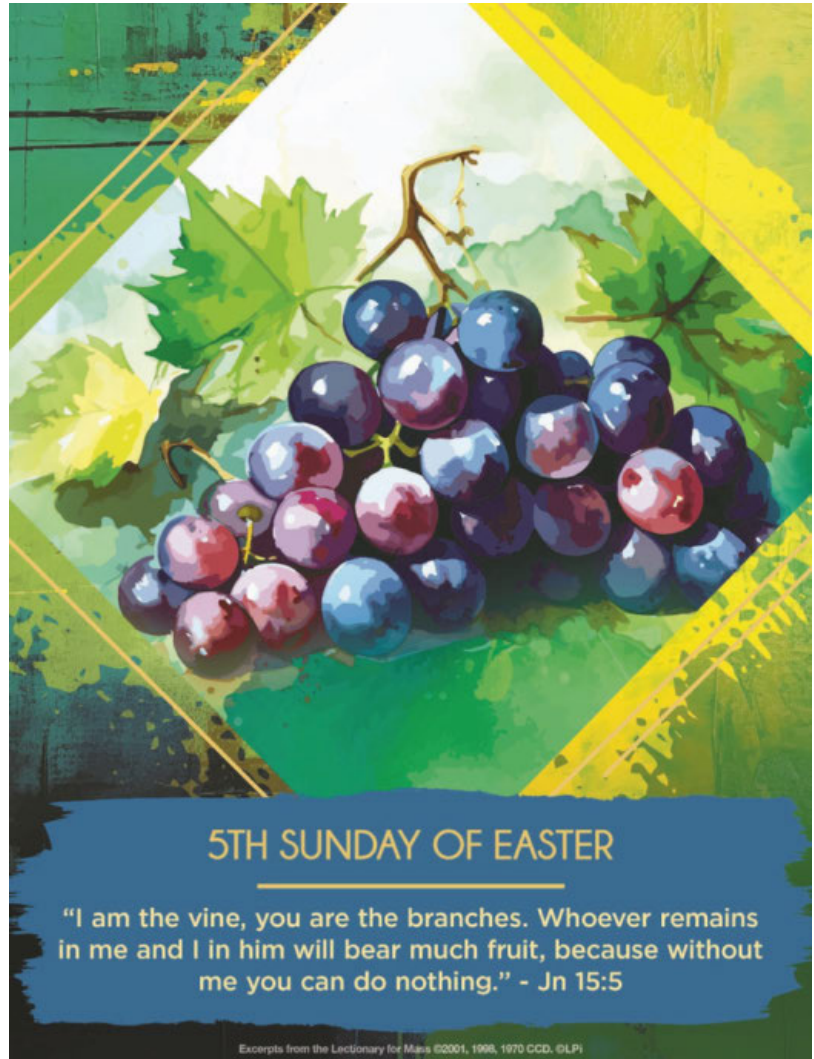

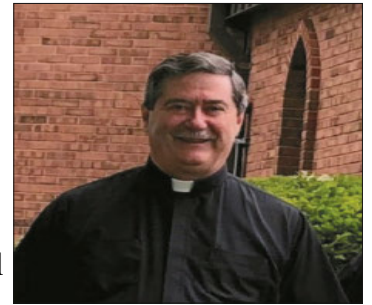

Speak Now or Forever Hold Your Peace

As many of you might already know, for the last five years, Mr. Tim Kurt of our parish has been studying in preparation for ordination as a permanent deacon for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Following the age-old custom of the Church, as maintained by Canon Law (Canon 1051, paragraph 2), it is my privilege to announce publicly that **Mr. Timothy Kurt** is a candidate for the major order of Sacred Diaconate, to be conferred on **June 8, 2024**, at 10:00 a.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis.



**Anyone who knows any reason why this candidate should not be ordained is bound to disclose this immediately to me or to the Office of Diaconate of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.**

We've been asked by the Office of Diaconate to communicate this announcement for two consecutive week-ends in the parish bulletin and using other forms of social media. Please join me in prayer for Mr. Kurt, and for each of the diaconate candidates, that these times of immediate preparation for ordination will be times of extra-ordinary grace and abiding peace.

I know that Tim Kurt, as Deacon, will do no less. Congratulations to Tim, his wife Sharon, and their family!

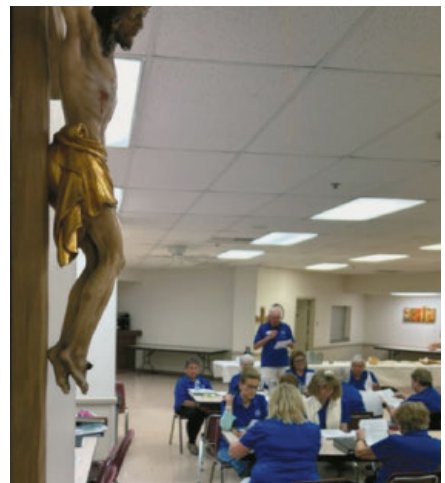

*Walking with Mary*

NINE CONSECUTIVE DAYS

MAY 5 — MAY 13

To honor and express our most tender love to our Holy Mother, Our Lady of Fatima, we will be offering her an Outdoor Rosary Novena while slowly walking the parish grounds. The nine days of prayer will walk us right to the Anniversary of the First Apparition in Fatima.
