


#### STEWARDSHIP DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



#### A Note for the Extraordinary Ministers

Dear Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist:

Please remember to purify your Pyx. Especially if you have to fracture a host, there could be small particles left in your Pyx. Put water in your Pyx and consume it so no particles remain.

Also, when bringing the Eucharist to the homebound or sick, bring a small white purificator, which you can get in the sacristy, in case someone spits out part of the host. The residue will need to be put in a cup of water and brought to a Priest or Deacon, who will take it to the sacristy for proper disposition.

#### **CHURCH RENOVATION UPDATE**

We have some exciting news to share with you! The pews have been ordered and we are on track for our summer renovation schedule. In an effort to maximize the beauty, comfort and longevity of our investment, the Church Renovation Committee has chosen to upgrade our pews to solid hardwood in lieu of wood veneer. We feel this will maximize the elegance of our long-term investment. In addition, we have chosen to upgrade the look of the pew frontals (the section in front of the first pew) with raised panel hardware to enhance the look of our worship space. We have also upgraded the pew seat back to a contoured seat to improve comfort. With these upgrades, the cost of the pews has increased by \$29,500. While we continue to execute our renovation with a focus on good stewardship of your donations, we believe this is a valued investment that will be enjoyed for generations. As such, we ask that you prayerfully consider a donation to offset the cost of these upgrades as we would greatly appreciate your generosity. Please recognize that any donation would be restricted to the church renovation project and not used for general parish expenses. 



#### 10 Reasons to DECLINE to Sign

Transforming society to respect and protect all innocent human life.

#### Parental Consent laws

If a "right" to abortion is enshrined in our Missouri Constitution it would allow abortions to be performed on pregnant minors without notice to or consent from the minor's parents.

#### 2 Late-term abortions on demand

If our Missouri Constitution is amended with a "right" to abortion, abortion will be allowed from conception to live birth, including late-term abortions.

#### 3 Abortion - all 9 months

If this amendment passes, abortions will be allowed for "physical or mental health" reasons all 9 months - from conception to live birth.

#### Health & Safety standards eliminated

Missouri law requires health and safety standards for abortion clinics. These would be eliminated if this amendment passes, and would allow anyone to perform abortions without a healthcare license

#### MO's 52+ pro-life laws will be eliminated

Our Missouri Constitution is our state's supreme (highest) law and governing document. Our prolife laws will be eliminated by enshrining a "right' to abortion in our Missouri Constitution.

#### Women lose ability to sue for malpractice



A woman's ability to seek criminal prosecution/civil penalty of any person who performs/assists/provides support to induce/seek/obtain an abortion will be eliminated.

#### PRCs forced to refer



Pregnancy Resource Centers will be forced to refer for abortion.

#### Ultrasounds eliminated



Abortion clinics will no longer be required to offer or show a mother her baby's ultrasound image.

#### Significant \$ Loss to MO



Missouri could suffer a significant loss to state and local revenue if this language is enshrined in the Missouri Constitution.

#### Taxpayer-funded abortion 10



If abortion is enshrined as a "right" in our Missouri Constitution, your legislator will be unable to refuse to appropriate funds to abortion providers.
