

As many of you might already know, for the last five years, Mr. Tim Kurt of our parish has been studying in preparation for ordination as a permanent deacon for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Following the age-old custom of the Church, as maintained by Canon Law (Canon 1051, paragraph 2), it is my privilege to announce publicly that **Mr. Timothy Kurt** is a candidate for the major order of Sacred Diaconate, to be conferred on **June 8, 2024**, at 10:00 a.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis.



Anyone who knows any reason why this candidate <u>should not</u> be ordained is bound to disclose this immediately to me or to the Office of Diaconate of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

We've been asked by the Office of Diaconate to communicate this announcement for two consecutive weekends in the parish bulletin and using other forms of social media. Please join me in prayer for Mr. Kurt, and for each of the diaconate candidates, that these times of immediate preparation for ordination will be times of extra-ordinary grace and abiding peace.

I know that Tim Kurt, as Deacon, will do no less. Congratulations to Tim, his wife Sharon, and their family!

## ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)





The St. Louis Sluggers are a Ministry of Queen of All Saints Society of St. Vincent de Paul

The Sluggers just returned from their fifth Mission to flood ravaged Humphries County, TN. They contributed nearly 5,000 hours assisting in the rebuilding of flood damaged homes.
