Under Anna's direction, our young people have already been participating in various events with other youth groups from neighboring parishes and the hope is to collaborate with our neighbors in creating a common ministry to youth, sharing ministerial leadership and financial resources. Its still just an idea at this stage, so please pray for the future of our youth and pray for Anna, thanking God for all she has done for Queen of All Saints and for all the good that she will do in the future at Ursuline Academy. THIRD SUNDAY COLLECTION FOR ST. ANTHONY FOOD PANTRY






