In 2023, this pregnancy center alone saw 446 new clients, provided 302 pregnancy tests and performed 199 ultrasounds! 

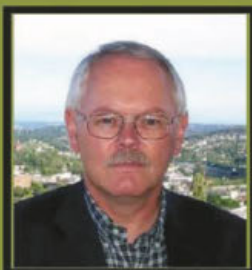

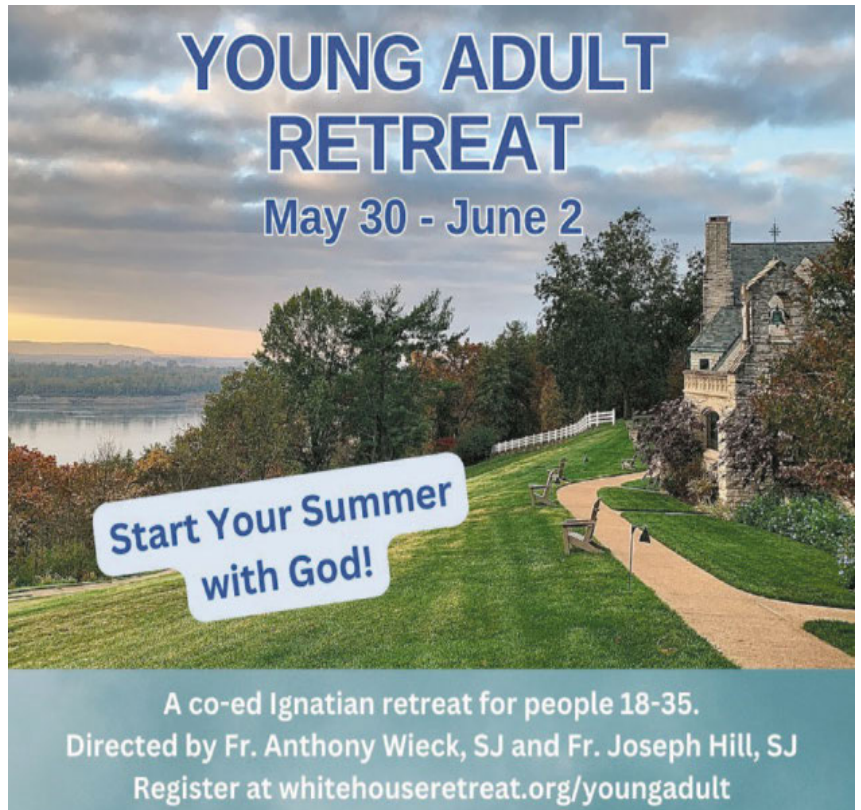
