FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

A little girl walked to and from school daily. Though the weather that morning was questionable and clouds were forming, she made her daily trek to elementary school. As the afternoon progressed, the winds whipped up, along with thunder and lightning. The mother of the little girl fled concerned that her daughter would be frightened as she walked home from school and she herself feared that the electrical storm might harm her child.



Following the roar of thunder, lightning, like a flaming sword, would cut through the sky. Full of concern, the mother quickly got into her car and drove along the route to her child's school. As she did so, she saw her little girl walking along, but at each flash of lightning, the child would stop, look up and smile. Another and another were to follow quickly and with each the girl would look at the streak of light and smile.

When the mother's car drew up beside the child she lowered the window and called to her, "What are you doing? Why do you keep stopping?" The child answered, "I am trying to look pretty. God keeps taking my picture."

The moral of the story? Keep smiling as you face the storms of life. God will keep blessing you.

So, I'm trying to smile as I face this storm in my life, as I leave this special parish. When it was first made known to me that Archbishop Rozanski was thinking of transferring me we were still in the Season of Lent and August seemed far away. When it was first announced to you that Fr. Detwiler and I were receiving new assignments it was May 27 and it would be nearly an entire summer before the move. Now, as I write this, it's just six days. As you read this, it's just one night. The effective date of transfer came quickly, like a storm that forms quickly and with haste darkens the sky. Still, I smile.

In my first column in this bulletin, dated August 11, 2019, I wrote this:

All through my life, and especially in the priesthood, I have been blessed incredibly by God. From the people in all the places I served I have been loved, inspired, and uplifted by their faith, service, and prayer. God has been very good to me. I'm confident the same blessings, and more, will come to me at this parish. Already, I am impressed with all that goes on here. This is a busy place! I look forward to joining with you in service of God and in manifesting the Kingdom of God in our little corner of His world. Please pray for me as I begin this assignment. Of course, I am praying for you.

I am so grateful that you answered my request by praying for me during these last four years. I thank God for the opportunity to have been stationed here and, true to my experience in other assignments, I have been incredibly blessed by you. It's like this - while walking along a deserted beach, a holy man found a pearl. A poor woman saw him pick it up and asked him to give it to her. The holy man did so cheerfully. The woman went off, singing for joy. She was now wealthy. A week later, the woman reappeared and returned the pearl to the man, saying, "Give me that which is more valuable than the pearl. Give me that which enabled you to give the pearl to me so cheerfully."

These past four years you have given me "that," that special, beautiful, extraordinary grace which is hard to encapsulate in only one word. You have given me "that" and I thank you from the bottom of my heart.

Now I entrust you to Fr. Murphy, Fr. D'Amico and Fr. Hopmeir. You'll be in good hands and they will share the goodness of Christ with you. Please pray for them.

FROM FR. JOSEPH DETWILER



“So they collected them, and filled twelve wicker baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves that had been more than they could eat.” (John 6:13). This verse comes at the end of the story in John’s Gospel where Jesus fed 5,000 people from 5 barley loaves and 2 fish. Jesus fed such a great crowd of people....out of *nothing*. We might think that is pretty generous, and yet in this last verse we learn that there is still so much left over, even after all the people have eaten and have been satisfied. We hear that Jesus is not just a Savior who merely provides the bare minimum for His people, but He gives lavishly and in great abundance.

I can’t help but think of this story when I look back at the last 2 years serving as a priest here at Queen of All Saints. It was such an absolute surprise to read my letter after walking on the front steps of the Cathedral, only minutes after being ordained a priest. I thought QAS was the *last* place I would ever be assigned, and somehow, that assignment was chosen for me. Although it was extremely confusing, I knew QAS is an amazing parish, and I was very excited to serve here. I have been thinking especially of this story in John 6 because I came to this parish after 9 years in seminary formation. After imagining hypothetical situations and considering what I would do if I were a priest in all types of situations. I had looked forward to priesthood for so many years, and it is natural for my imagination to try to visualize how wonderful priesthood would be one day. I have to say, after just 2 short years being a priest here....all of my thoughts about priesthood were a total and complete understatement. My experience serving you all as your spiritual father has been better than I could have ever imagined. I have absolutely loved all the time I got to spend around school (and trolling on your kids and acting like I am going to steal their lunch), in youth group, RCIA, Knights of Columbus, and so many other organizations. You all have been so generous to me, and supported me with your actions and your prayer. I have loved being your spiritual father, thank you all for having such a huge impact on my life in my first priestly assignment.

So.....we know that God is a God of abundance. We see that when we look back at how He has provided for us in the past, and we can look around and see that in the present. Let that be the source of our confidence in the future. We can walk forward in trust, not because we have it all figured out, but because of who God is and how He Loves us. Thank you so much for being an instrument of God’s Love for me these past 2 years. You have changed me, and I love you all. And this will ALWAYS be the *first* place where I was known as “Father.” And I am so grateful for all that God has given me, and I am confident that there is still so much more in store.
