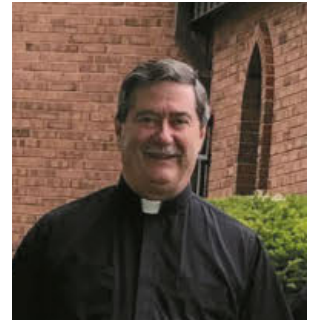
"For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable." - ROMANS 11:29
