

Dear Parishioners,

I am happy to announce that Queen of All Saints Parish will be hosting seminarians from Kenrick Seminary again this year to help facilitate their pastoral formation. The seminarians' pastoral formation takes place in a parish setting and varies from year to year. Students in their fourth year are ordained Deacons and serve in that capacity in a parish. Third year students work in areas of Religious Education, those in second year work in the pastoral care of the sick and dying, and those in first year work with either youth or with the poor.

We will be hosting third year student, **Cesar Gomez-Cervantes**, and first year student **Samuel Gerbic.** Seminarians are expected to participate in Sunday Masses and work for 3-4 hours during the week doing pastoral work. I will be meeting with Cesar and Samuel very soon to determine the ministries in which they will be involved. They will be working at Queen of All Saints Parish until the end of April 2024. Join me in welcoming Cesar and Samuel on the weekend of September 10th at all the Masses.
