FROM OUR PASTOR



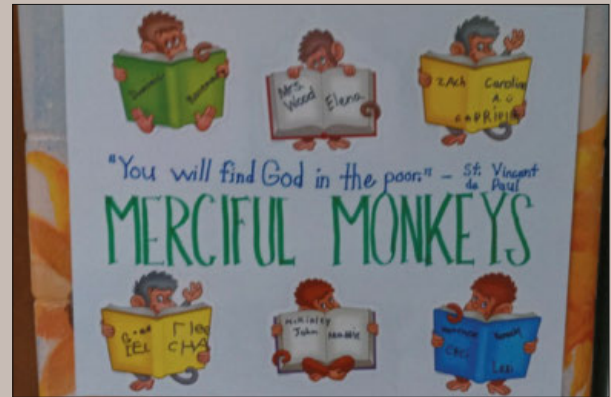
Dear Parishioners,

There are so many disasters and crises happening in our world these days that it is hard to retain any sense of compassion and sympathy towards them for very long. The deadly fire in Maui, the

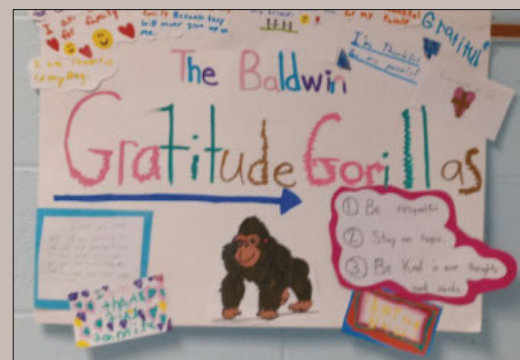
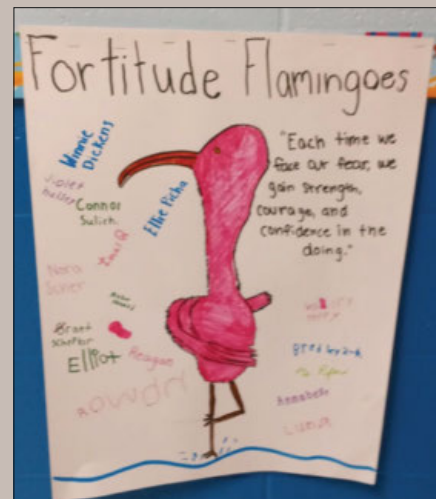

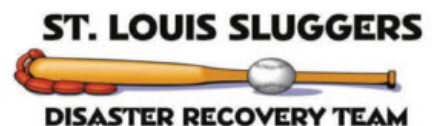
