**STEWARDSHIP
THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD**

"John answered them all, 'I baptize you with water; but he who is mightier than I is coming...he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit...'"

- Luke 3:16

The Catholic Catechism states that "Jesus' immersion in the water is a sign for all human beings of the need to die to themselves to do God's will." In other words, as baptized Catholics there is only one gift that we need to give to Jesus - the gift of ourselves. Surrender yourself to God, place your trust in Him and allow the Holy Spirit to work through you for the greater glory of God.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Fr. Murphy needs some help with his bulletin column so he volunteered me (or I might have volunteered in a weak moment before I had my morning cup of coffee). Quite a few people have asked for my lasagna recipe since that Heritage lunch when I first got here. So here goes:

Meat sauce:

Take 1.5 to 2 pounds of ground beef (The leanest you like) and 1/2 pound of sausage or salsiccia and burn them together in a skillet or frying pan. When done, put on some paper towels to soak up the excess grease. Add to a pot or crock pot of spaghetti sauce. I prefer Prego myself but use what you like. Add a small can of tomato paste, rosemary, thyme, basil to taste. Let simmer for a couple of hours.

Ricotta filling:

Use 2 pounds of ricotta cheese (Yes there is a BIG difference than cottage cheese). Add 2 eggs, parmesan cheese, salt and pepper to taste and mix thoroughly. Some people like to add chopped parsley.

Making and baking:

Preheat your oven to 350 degrees.

Spray a 9 X 12 baking dish with a nonstick spray. You can use precooked noodles or the no cook ones. Both are good. Put a layer of noodles on the bottom. You can put a thin layer of tomato sauce on the noodles if you like. Add a layer of the ricotta cheese, then a layer of the meat sauce, then a layer of mozzarella cheese (shredded or sliced). Repeat.

Put the baking dish on top of a cookie sheet (in case of overflow while cooking).

Put into oven about the middle shelf and cook for 30-40 minutes. Let cool for a couple of minutes before cutting. Of course, the first will always come out messy.

This past year we removed stairlifts no longer needed and placed them with families that had mobility issues. Often the lift allows the family member to remain in their own home rather than move into a facility.

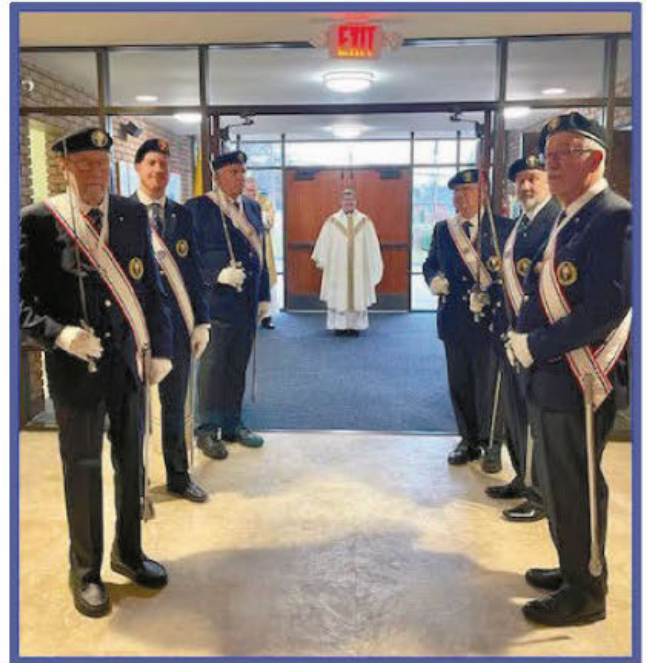
Currently we have families in need of stairlifts. If you, a relative or friend have a stairlift you no longer need we can remove and find it a good home.

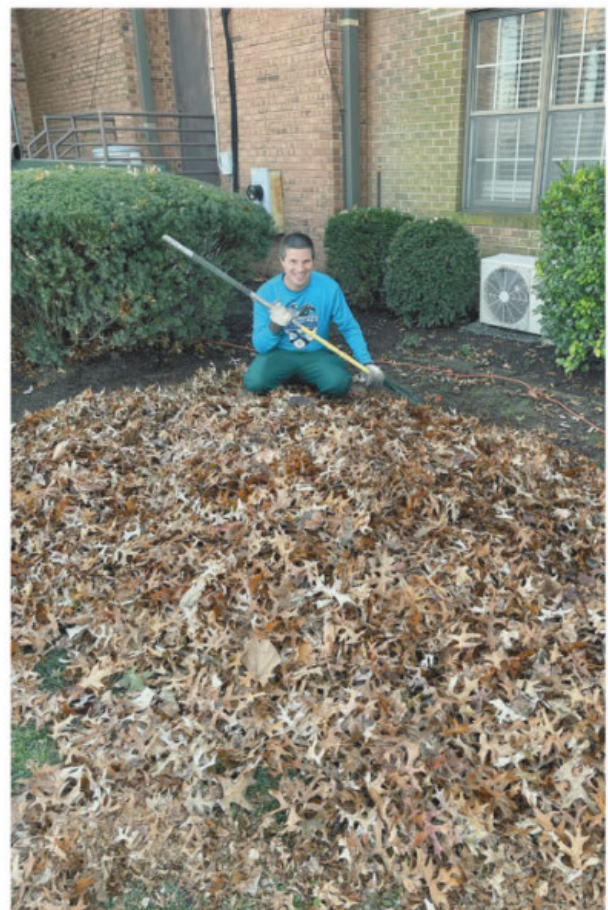
