Ezra's instructions to the people shows us that Gpd does not forbid us from enjoying the good things in life. He wants us to be happy! However, God expects us to be grateful for all that He has given us and to generously share our blessings with those who are in need. Now here's the hard part - to share all we have without expecting anything in return.

FROM OUR PASTOR

This week I thought I might give an update on issues and projects that the QAS Maintenance Committee is dealing with. Most parishioners aren't aware of the maintenance activities that are currently happening "behind the scenes". The Maintenance Committee works hand in hand with our Finance Committee to keep the parish buildings and property in good shape. The following is a list of issues that we are currently dealing with.

- Final details of the Church renovation and pew replacement
- The outdated grease trap in the school cafeteria had to be replaced (just in time for the Lenten Fish Frys)
- Several windows in the church need to be sealed and caulked
- We're in the process of setting up a service agreement for the HVAC systems in the parish
- Foundation Recovery Systems have been working with us to locate and stop a leak into the school basement
- We are receiving bids to repair, repave or seal the playground area and various parts of the parking lot
- Looking to replace the roof on the lower level of the school
- Old pipes are breaking and are being replaced in the school basement
- Various windows in the rectory need to be replaced.
- All the Pin Oaks on the parish grounds including the two in the rectory front yard will need to be cut down because of an invasion of "Gall Wasps" which is killing the trees. (I would love to find a way to save these trees!!)
- The school basement storage areas are being cleaned out
- And we have been waiting for close to two years for St Louis County to approve the installation of a cell tower which will provide the parish with monthly income. The tower would be incorporated into a light standard on one of the soccer fields.

Besides these, there are hundreds of minor issues that need to be addressed. I'm grateful to the people who volunteer to address these issues on our Maintenance and Finance Committees. Without their help I would be LOST.
