“The stone that the builders rejected has become the corner stone...”
- MATTHEW 21:42

Saying grace before a meal in a restaurant may attract some strange looks from some. But to others it is a sign that God is alive and well!

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

In 2021 the National Council of Catholic Bishops inaugurated a “National Eucharistic Revival” in order to renew within the church a fresh awareness of the true presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. A recent Pew survey discovered that 70% of Catholics do not believe that Christ is present, body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. The majority of Catholics believe that the Eucharist is merely symbolic of Christ’s presence. This explains why so many Catholics do not feel a need to go to Mass on Sunday. In technologically advanced cultures, people find it difficult to accept as truth anything that cannot be proven scientifically. The presence of Christ in the Eucharist is a supernatural event and requires faith, not scientific evidence.

In the seminary, one of our professors gave us an assignment to research what the early church believed about the eucharist. The whole point was to show that from the very beginning, the apostles, the disciples of the apostles, the early church fathers, and the early Christians, clearly and beyond a doubt believed in and experienced Christ’s REAL presence in the Eucharist. Those who receive communion symbolically are oblivious to the incredible love and power that comes to us in Christ. When we go to Mass only accepting Christ’s presence symbolically, it’s like owning an airplane and taking it on a trip from St Louis to Denver driving it on highway 70, not realizing that we have the capacity to FLY. We will eventually get to Denver driving the airplane, but it is so much easier and faster to FLY!

In the upcoming months there will be more attention dedicated to National Eucharist Renewal, but in the meantime ask Jesus for the grace to believe in His presence in a deeper way especially after receiving communion and drop by church when you get a chance to spend a few moments in silent prayer with the Lord. Church is open everyday (Mon-Sat) until around 4pm and there is all day adoration on Tuesdays from 9am until 7:30pm.
