### **Hurricane Disaster: People Need Help!**


The Archdiocese of St. Louis has sent a memo to all parishes requesting collections to be taken up to aid the peoples of Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia who are suffering from the ravages of Hurricane Helene. Over 230 people have been killed in the wake of this storm and the death toll is likely to rise. People are without shelter, food, water, electricity and are in dire need of help.

As I write this pastor's column, another hurricane is moving quickly towards Florida. The National Weather Service just updated Hurricane Milton to a category 5 hurricane and will hit the Tampa Bay area on Wednesday evening as a Cat 3 storm. By the time you are reading this, Hurricane Milton will have hit the west coast of Florida and there will no doubt be more devasting destruction and loss of life. These are the times that we can really make a difference. If you choose to help, place your contribution in an envelope marked "Hurricane Relief" and place it in the collection on Sunday or drop it off at the rectory during the week. Make checks out to "Queen of All Saints Parish" and write "Hurricane" in the memo line. All contributions will be forwarded Catholic Charities in the affected areas. **PLEASE HELP**
