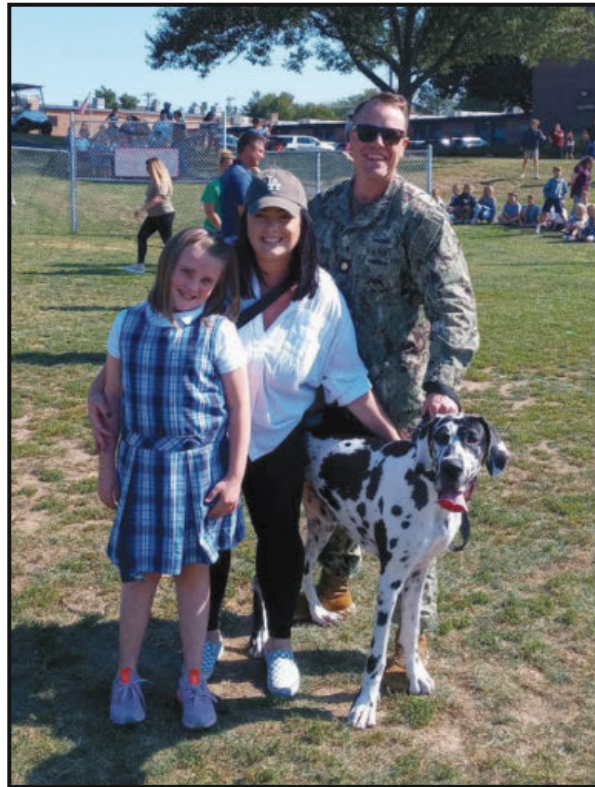

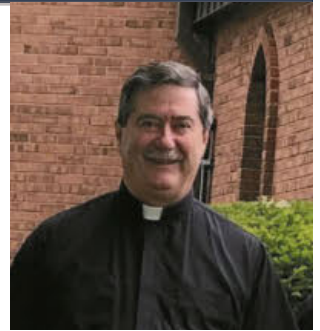
“My God will fully supply whatever you need...” - PHILIPPIANS 4:19

You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.

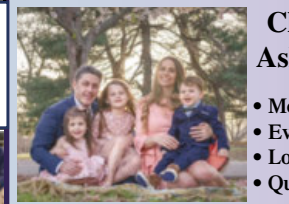
