

FROM OUR PASTOR

O COME LET US ADORE HIM!

Christmas is not the only time of year that we need to hear and heed the call to adore Christ, our Lord and Savior. From the beginning of Christianity, the followers of Jesus recognized His true and living presence in the Eucharist. It is evident from the writings of the apostles, the disciples of the apostles and the early church Fathers that they understood Jesus to be truly present in a real way, body, blood, soul and divinity in the Eucharist. Although most if not all Christian churches have discarded any belief in the True Presence, we as Catholics still hold to the belief, of the risen Christ in the Eucharist. But we do not just hold to "a belief". For those who have faith, it is an experience of the living risen Christ.

For that reason, in Catholic Churches, we reverence Christ's presence in the tabernacle, bowing, genuflecting and making the sign of the cross because we know that He is truly there. When I was growing up, it was a common practice for many Catholics to drop in church to make a quick visit. Many people adopted the practice of making the sign of the cross when driving by a Catholic church out of reverence for the presence of Christ. But most of all, the practice of adoring Christ in the Eucharist was a common devotion. Many churches hosted Holy Hours, 40 Hours of Adoration and some even had Perpetual Adoration.

Here at Queen of All Saints we have been slowly expanding the hours of Adoration, creating more opportunities for parishioners to drop in at church and make a visit. We currently have adoration in the main church on Tuesdays following the 8:15 mass until 7pm. We offer the opportunity to adore Christ on Mondays and Wednesdays in the Cry room following the 8:15 mass until 4pm. We are ready to expand adoration to Thursdays, but we need just one more person to make a commitment to the 11am hour. I know that many people work during the day but still, there must be someone out there with time on their hands. Our goal is not only to expand adoration to 6 days of the week, but also someday to have an Adoration chapel and restore perpetual adoration.

Please pray about this. We live in crazy and uncertain times, and it is our faith in Jesus that gives us a rock foundation to have hope and witness to the world that Jesus is truly risen!

ALSO: Our country is divided over so many things, especially politics. That division has even invaded our church. While the church cannot by law recommend political candidates, it can speak out on issues and the Catholic Church has been crystal clear from the beginning of its existence till now in its condemnation of abortion as an intrinsic moral evil. The wording of Amendment 3 is deceptive and misleading as are the ads that promote it. We do not need to enshrine the killing of innocent human life into the constitution of the state of Missouri!!





- Catechists choose the masses to lead CLW which are convenient for their schedules.




