WHAT'S UP WITH THE QAS YOUTH GROUP?

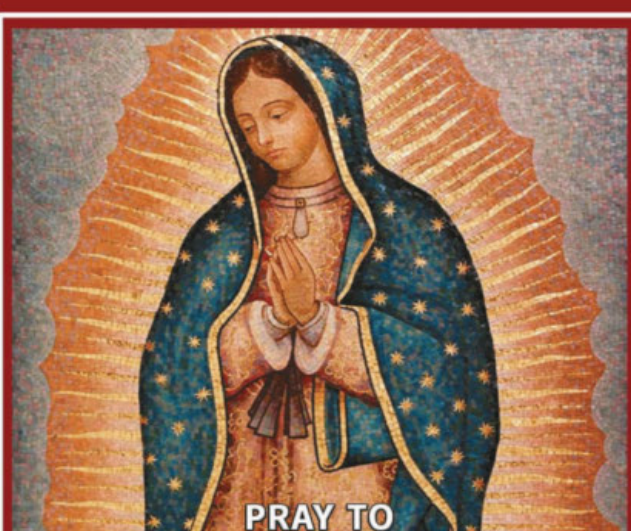
For the last two months, I have been involved in discussions with the pastors of area parishes and representatives of the Southern Vicariate in regard to forming a unified South County youth ministry. A lot of work was put into the process of creating a plan, exploring the finances and interviewing potential youth director candidates. But for various reasons, the endeavor has come to a halt; it doesn't look like it will work out at this time. I hope to meet soon with members of the QAS Core Team to begin the search for a Youth Ministry Director. I am grateful for the volunteers who stepped forward to manage our youth group during this process. We will continue to collaborate with the youth groups from our neighboring parishes in various ways as we have done in the past. In the meantime, Queen of All Saints Youth Ministry will continue on as is. I will provide more information in the near future as it becomes available.

VOTE VOTE VOTE

We are less than two weeks away from Election Day and voter turnout is expected to be heavy. I tried to vote *Absentee Without An Excuse* twice now and was unable to even find a parking space at Cliff Cave Branch Library. Both times, the voting lines stretched outside the library. The importance of voting in this election is huge, especially with Amendment 3. I'm encouraging every parishioner of voting age to make sure they show up to vote and **say NO to Amendment 3**. 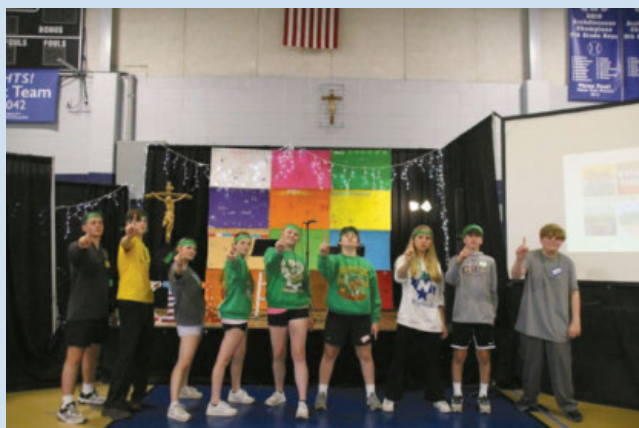

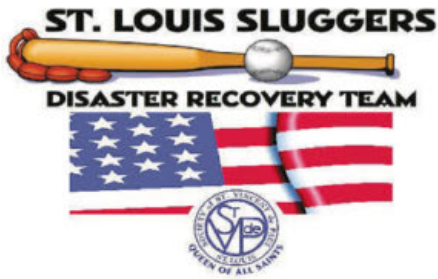
