

I am grateful for the volunteers who stepped forward to manage our youth group during this process. We will continue to collaborate with the youth groups from our neighboring parishes in various ways as we have done in the past. In the meantime, Queen of All Saints Youth Ministry will continue on as is. I will provide more information in the near future as it becomes available.

### **VOTE VOTE VOTE**


