QUEEN’S DERBY AUCTION

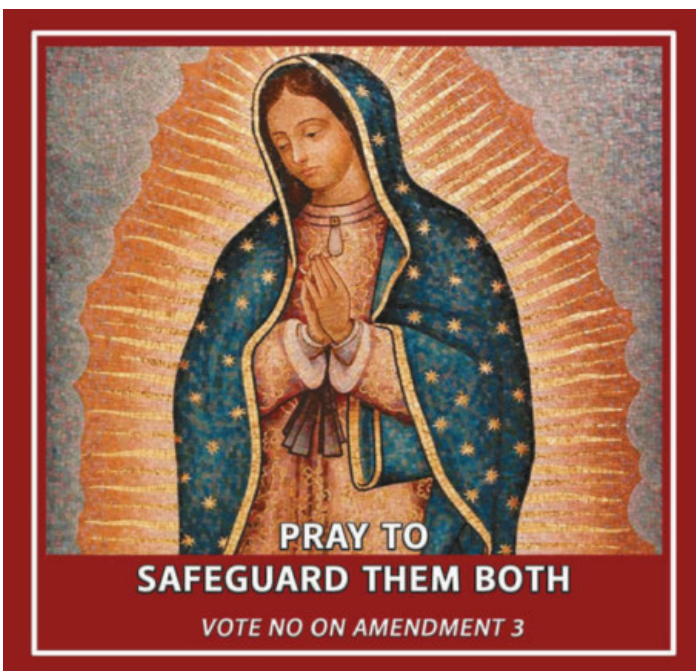

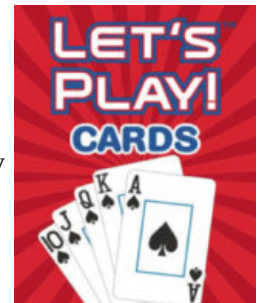
