#### Where is our "Homer Smith"?

Homer Smith is the main character in a novel called *The Lillies of the Field*. The novel was made into a movie in 1963 starring Sidney Poitier, who won an Academy Award for best actor, playing the role of Homer Smith. In the partially true story, Homer Smith, who just got out of the army, is exploring the west in his recently purchased station wagon. He passes some Catholic nuns trying to repair a fence row and he stops to help them. The


nuns become convinced that he was sent by God to build a chapel for them. It took a while for them to convince Homer, but he finally comes through and builds the chapel for them.

For years, parishioners at Queen of All Saints parish have been wanting to build an Adoration Chapel (and a large gathering area). But the dream has never come close to being realized because we lack our version of "Homer Smith" (A very rich Homer Smith!). Since our parish financial situation at the moment prohibits us from pursuing such a dream, I thought I would just take a shot in the dark and ask if we have any financially blessed parishioners who would like to leave a legacy for themselves or their families. A capital campaign is out of the question for now, but there might be a family or families willing and capable of making the dream of having a chapel and possibly a large gathering area a reality. I figure there is no harm in asking.

In the meantime, until we have a dedicated adoration chapel, we have been kicking around the idea of using the cry room in church as a chapel during the week. Tuesday Adoration would continue in church as usual. **Nothing has been decided, this is still just an idea.** But if we proceed, we will need a number of people to fill in the hours necessary to have sustained adoration all week long. Keep praying to the Lord to send us our "Homer Smith."

\*\*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
