
## **CHURCH INTERIOR RENOVATION UPDATE**

As many of you know, for years, Queen of All Saints Parish has been planning to replace the aging pews in church along with the flooring, paint the ceiling and to do some renovation work on other areas in the church. Msgr. Hambrough signed the contract for the construction of new pews back in the summer. The funding for this project has already been received through donations by the parishioners as part of the Archdiocesan Beyond Sunday campaign and our own QAS *Growing in Christ!* capital improvement contributions. We continue to use this restricted fund for all designated

capital improvement projects such as the church and school HVAC upgrades, new roofs, parking lot renovations, etc. With the remaining funds, we will complete the renovations of the church and continue to replace HVAC systems on the school, as well as a few other minor designated improvements.

Over the last several months, a special committee was formed to work out the details of the project. They were tasked with selecting the style and color of the pews, the type of flooring and find the best company to do the work. Our pew committee is close to completing their work. The next step is to find the best time to install the flooring and pews. Once the work begins the church will not be available to us for eight to ten weeks. We would need to find another place to celebrate Masses on Sunday and during the week. The original plan was to begin the project in mid-February with the hope of completing it in time for Easter Sunday. But that does not seem feasible now because of the heavy use of the gym and school facilities. The current plan is to begin the project in early June, the day after the parish picnic. Once the renovation begins, we will celebrate Sunday Masses in the school cafeteria and weekday Masses in the church basement. I'm not sure what we will do for weddings or funerals during this time. I don't think anyone wants to get married or be buried from a cafeteria! (Although it would make it easier to flow from the funeral Mass right into the funeral luncheon....hmmm.). The cafeteria is ideal because with school being out for the Summer, we can set up the chairs and altar and leave them in place for the length of the project. Meetings could still be held during the week. This is where we stand now. Of course, plans can still change, and we will keep you updated.




#### **CHRISTMAS SHARING PROGRAM**

With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Complete your personal information. Please enter your legal first name (no nicknames) for the purpose of the background screening.

Create a username, password and password clue. \*\*\*\*(BE SURE TO SAVE THIS INFORMATION TO AVOID RE-REGISTERING. DOUBLE BACKGROUND CHECKS ARE COSTLY TO OUR PARISH!!!)

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to <u>submit information for a background screening</u>, register for a **\*\*Protecting God's Children work**shop, view TWO ONLINE TRAINING MODULES and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct. You have to complete <u>ALL</u> steps to <u>complete the process</u>.

\*\*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
