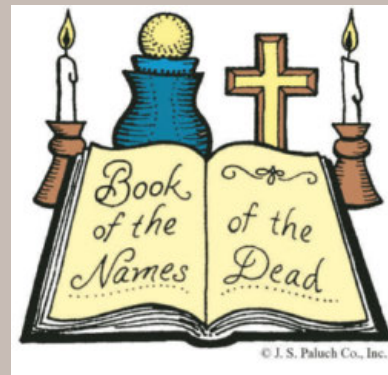

Dan grew up in QAS parish and was involved in QAS sports, choir, as well as being a server. He was a 2001 graduate of St. John Vianney High School, earning Gold Circle and Marianist awards. After graduating from Southeast Missouri State University, Dan was commissioned into the U.S. Army. Sadly, he was killed in action on June 23, 2007 in Taji, Iraq. To honor his sacrifice, his family established a scholarship fund at Vianney High School. Dan is a hero and his ultimate sacrifice will never be forgotten.

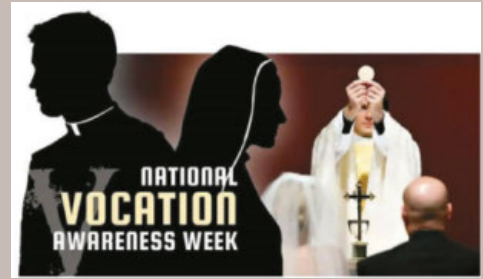

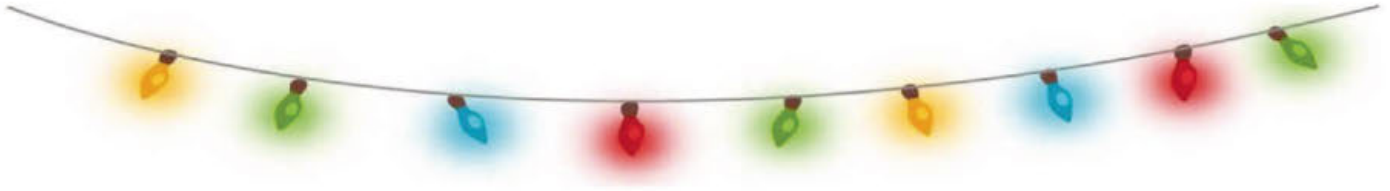

ACTS SQUARE DANCE



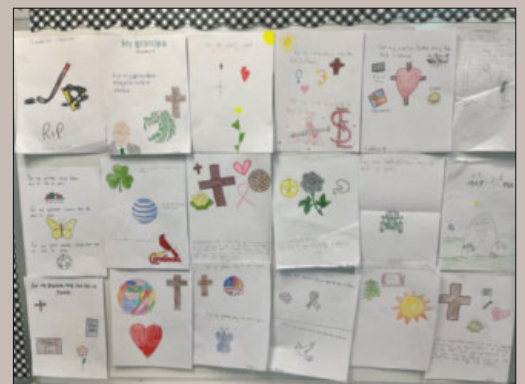
Last Saturday the QAS ACTS hosted a Square Dance. Lots of fun was had by all and they will be back next fall.

With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a **Protecting God's Children workshop, view TWO ONLINE TRAINING MODULES and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct. You have to complete ALL steps to complete the process.

****If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.**

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, **you will need your User name and Password**. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
