

It's blanket-making time again! Where did the year go?! Before we dive into all the preparations for Christmas, let's do something to focus on the real meaning – giving hope.

Please join us on Sunday, December 1, in the QAS cafeteria. It will be open from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. to make your blanket along with all of us. It's always a fun atmosphere and a great way to kick off the Advent season. We will also gratefully accept any new or clean, gently used blankets on this day.



To make your fleece blanket, you will need two pieces of fleece material, two yards each, along with a pair of good, sharp scissors. We will provide everything else. If you would like to make your blanket before this event and need instructions, please contact Therese Ruzicka at 314-605-4100. If you are not able to drop off your blanket on December 1, you can drop it off at the parish rectory office during normal business hours or contact Therese to drop off at her house or to have it picked up from your house.

This will be the 13th year for Blankets of Hope. During this time our parish has delivered over 1,000 of these blankets to St. Patrick's Center in downtown St. Louis where they will again be handed out to clients who are in great need. As they use these blankets to try to stay warm in the bitter cold, they will be reminded that there are people out there who love and care for them, and that will truly give them hope.




