

"And to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, with all your strength, and to love your neighbor as yourself is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices."

Of all the gifts that God gives us, the one He wants the most is our heart. He wants us to share out of our love for Him, not out of obligation. Using our talent in parish ministry and contributing money to support our parish mission is important, but it's more important to spend time in prayer with God daily and discern how He is calling us to be generous with all of our gifts. Not just the visible ones, but the invisible ones like love, mercy and forgiveness.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Jesus: A Cause of Division. "Do not think that I have come to bring peace upon the earth. I have come to bring not peace but the sword." *Mt 10:34*

This quote from Jesus, found in the Gospel of Matthew, warned his disciples that if they chose to follow him, they would be a cause for conflict in the world. In all ages, since the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Gospel message, proclaimed by the Church, has been vehemently and even violently opposed by the "spirit of the world". In our day, this vehement opposition is especially embodied in the rage against the Catholic Church's teaching that abortion is a grave sin and an intrinsic moral evil! The Church has taught this truth from the beginning and continues to proclaim that the killing of innocent human beings in their mother's womb is unconscionable. The decision to have an abortion is NOT as some people erroneously believe, a matter of conscience no more than throwing a newborn into a dumpster is a matter of conscience. As Missourians go to the polls this election cycle, we are being asked to make a choice whether or not to enshrine abortion in the constitution of the state of Missouri. As Catholics we must choose between bowing down to the spirit of the culture or bowing down to God. Do not think for one moment that God is in favor of destroying the very life that He has created and endowed with a soul! It's sad that there is so much division and conflict in our world. But conflict and division are what happens when we pledge our allegiance to the spirit of the world and ignore the voice of God!

Vote NO on Amendment 3.

**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
