



Our New Social Media Coordinator



Christmas is Coming

This is just an advance heads up regarding the Christmas Mass schedule. On Sunday, December 24th we begin the 4th week of Advent. It is the shortest 4th week of Advent that we can possibly have; it lasts a total of three hours. At 4pm that same day, we begin the celebration of Christmas Eve. We will be celebrating two Masses at 4pm, one in the church and one in the gymnasium. The next Mass on Christmas Eve will be at 10pm. There will be no 6pm or 12 Midnight Masses. Midnight Mass is the least attended of all the Christmas Masses followed by the 6pm Mass. On Christmas Day, Masses will be celebrated at 7:30am and 10am. The schedule will of course be published in the bulletin in the upcoming weeks and thanks to Katie Barcom, through a whole host of Social Media venues.






