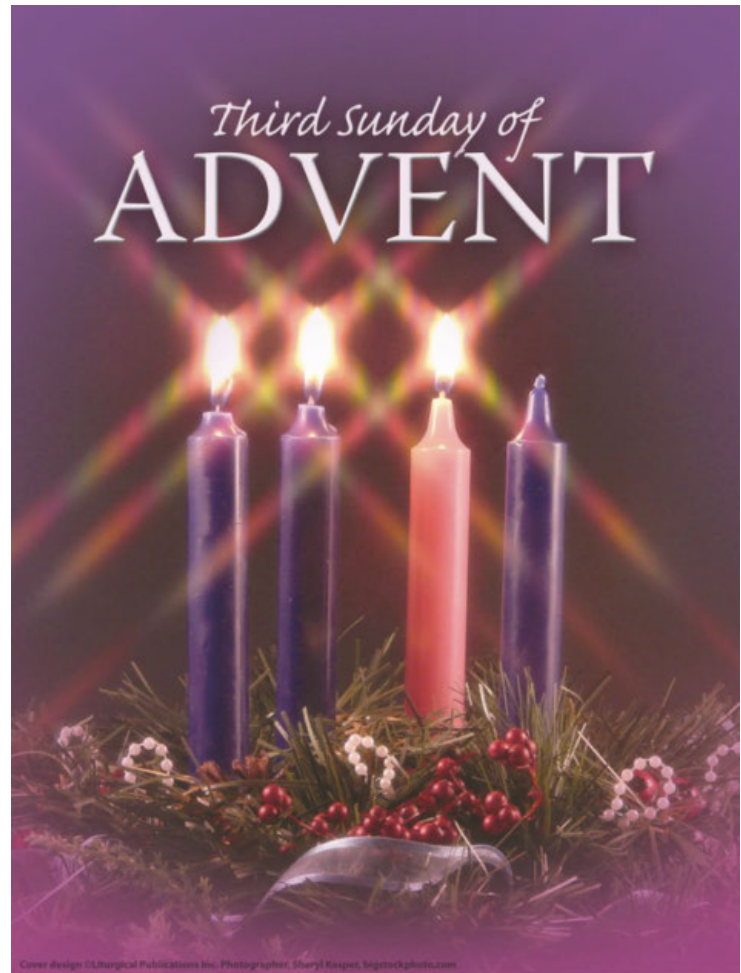

"Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." — 1 THESSALONIANS 5:16 - 18

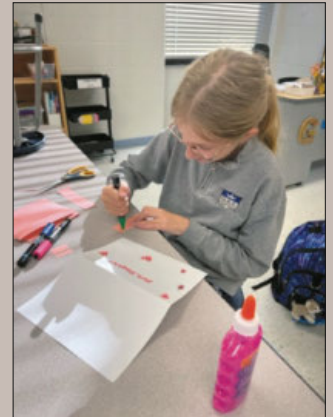

Congratulations to Theodore Clem who was baptized after the noon Mass on Sunday, December 10th.



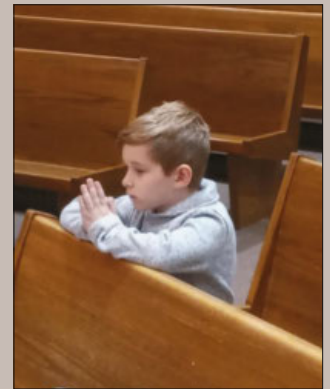
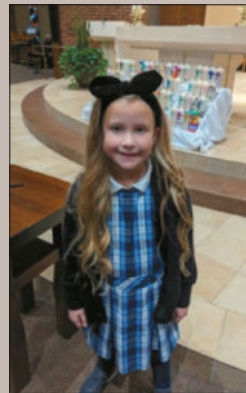
FAITH FAMILIES

You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
