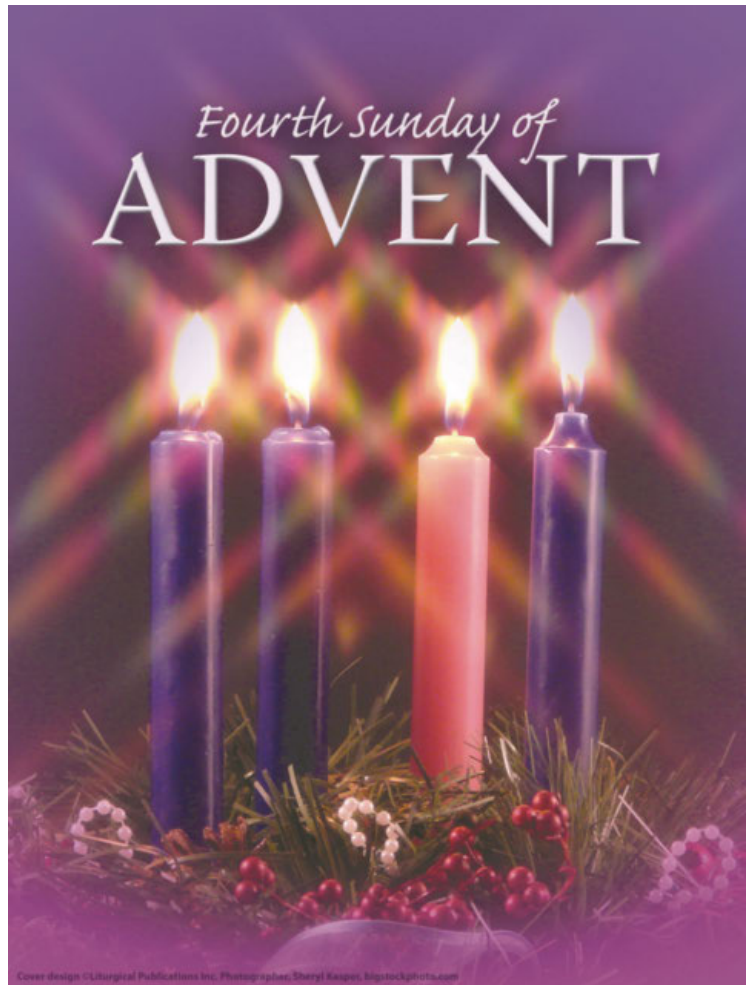

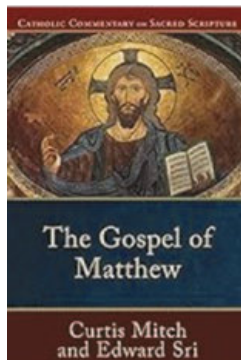


**ADULT FAITH OPPORTUNITY**
