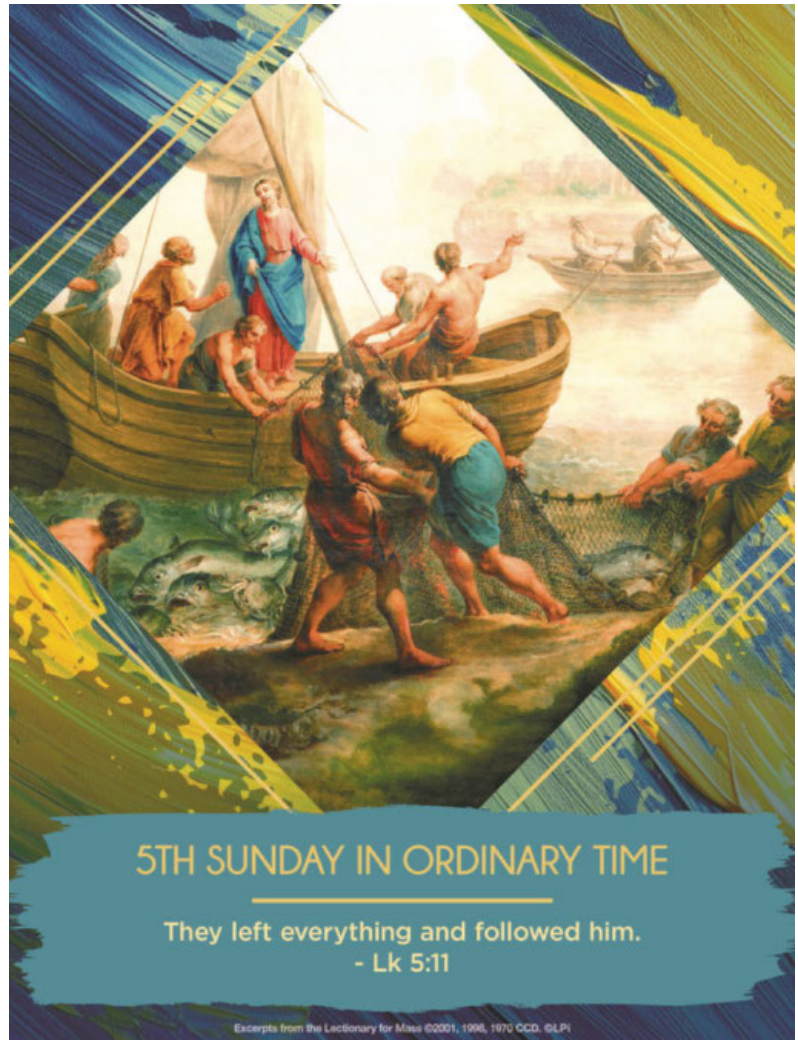

**BAPTISMAL PREPARATION**

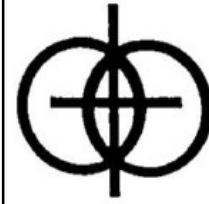
