


"He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick no food, no sack, no money in their belts."

EXPECTANT MOTHER'S BLESSING







MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP - TWO BY TWO

After the end to the pandemic, many are wondering "are people going to come back to Church?" Maybe the question should be "what are we going to do to invite people back?" Some parishes have decided to contact parishioners that they haven't heard from in a while and invite them back. But, if we haven't seen them prior to the pandemic, what was changed at our parish to encourage them to return? Instead, let's use today's Gospel as a model - let's go out "two by two" and walk with people in their faith journey. Let's train our parish disciples to be disciplemakers. Instead of starting big and calling people that were lukewarm to begin with, let's start small and train our "on fire" disciples how to lead small faith groups and how to easily share their faith story with others. Then, encourage people in our small faith groups to go out and do the same - this is called spiritual multiplication. The key - we need to personally invest in a few people at a time and accompany them in their faith journey.

Caregiving for persons with dementia can be both rewarding and depleting - an act of love cushioned in feelings of burnout, despair, and loneliness. The question becomes: who cares for the caregiver?

DETAILS

This workshop will focus on exploring support for the caregiver, support that will come both from the caregiver him- or herself and from the community.

- Dr. Kaori Sakurai, a gerontologist with expertise in dementia care, will share thoughts about healthy approaches to caregiving that take into account the needs of the caregiver as well as the person being cared for.
- Cheryl Kinney, LCSW, a licensed social worker with expertise in dementia care, will share a person-centered approach to communicating with and providing support to individuals with dementia.
- Coke Hennessy, a Mindfulness Teacher certified through U C Berkeley and certified in dementia care through the Alzheimer's Association, will share ideas of self-care available to refresh and replenish the caregiver physically, emotionally, and mentally.
- Maria Miskovic, MSW, LCSW, from Care Choice Care Management, an organization which works with families of persons with dementia to find optimal care for everyone involved, will discuss resources available in our community to support caregivers.

You will then be prompted to <u>submit information for a background screening</u>, register for a ****Protecting God's Children work**shop, view TWO ONLINE TRAINING MODULES and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct. You have to complete <u>ALL</u> steps to <u>complete the process</u>.

**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
