CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

WHAT IS CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD?



CLW is the Sunday gospel message presented to children who are 4 to 8 years old in a way that is meaningful and appropriate to them. CLW is offered at all 10:30 am Sunday masses.

DO WE HAVE TO SIGN UP IN ADVANCE?

No! Simply send your child to the altar for a blessing when the priest invites the children forward.



HOW DO I KNOW MY CHILD IS SAFE?



CLW leaders have all taken Protecting God's Children. In addition, all leaders have been trained on what to do in case of emergency (tornado, earthquake, fire and intruder).

DOES CLW LAST THE ENTIRE MASS?

CLW takes place during the Litrugy of the Word and Prayers of the Faithful. Children return to their parents during the Offertory.



WHAT DO THE KIDS DO DURING CLW?



During CLW, children begin in prayer, hear the Gospel message and participate in an age-appropriate discussion. Children then complete an activity related to the gospel, recite the creed and close in prayer.

You will then be prompted to <u>submit information for a background screening</u>, <u>register for a **Protecting God's Children workshop</u>, <u>view TWO ONLINE TRAINING MODULES and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct</u>. You have to complete <u>ALL</u> steps to complete the process.

**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding.
