



Blest Art works in support of the dwindling number of Catholics and Christians in the Holy Land who are facing extreme difficulty and persecution. They describe their mission in the following statement:



"Here at Blest Art, our mission is simple, to encourage growth in the diminishing population by ensuring these beautiful, handcrafted pieces can reach you.... We work closely with Catholic churches in the United States to preserve the presence of Christianity in the Holy Land and bring awareness to their mission. Wars and violence have affected tourist trade so greatly that for centuries, many of the Christians in the Holy Land have based their livelihoods on creating and distributing these crafts."

They offer a nice selection of statues, rosaries, ornaments, nativity sets, crucifixes, jewelry and much more. We often welcome missionaries and others who ask us to support their work in the United States around the world with our free will contributions. "Blest Art" seeks our support through the sale of the beautiful artwork created by Christian artisans in the middle east struggling to survive. 
