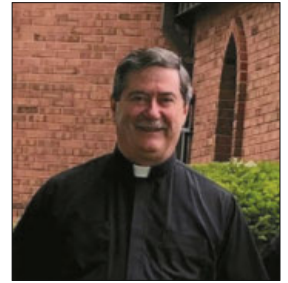
*“If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all.”

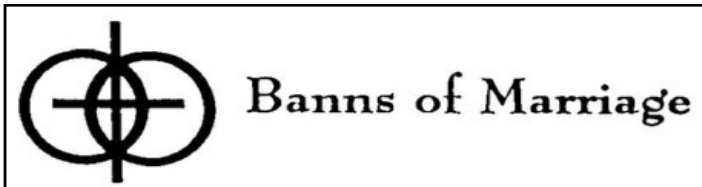

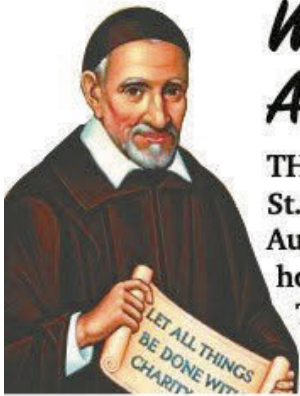
