

FROM OUR PASTOR

VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT 3!

The General Elections are a little over a month away and as happens in every election year there is conflict and challenges that we must face as Catholics. One of the more contentious items on the ballot in Missouri is Amendment 3 which according to "Fair Ballot Language" will enshrine the right to abortion at any time of pregnancy in the Missouri Constitution. Additionally, it will prohibit any regulation of abortion, including regulations designed to protect women undergoing abortions and prohibit any civil or criminal recourse against anyone who performs an abortion and hurts or kills the pregnant woman."

Ever since human beings began to walk the face of the earth, human life has entered this world through the wombs of women. It is the natural way God has established for creating human life and bringing human beings into the world. Our savior Jesus Christ, himself, entered this world through the womb of His mother Mary and just as Jesus became a human being from the moment of His conception, so too, every one of us is endowed with a soul at the moment of conception. The church has condemned abortion and the practice of infanticide for over two thousand years. We do not need to enshrine this horrible practice in the Constitution of the State of Missouri, or anywhere. As Catholics we have the right to speak out on the issues in elections that we find important. And this is important!

PLEASE VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT 3!

Having said that, we need to also pray for men and women considering aborting their children and those who have already done so. Many of the people who seek abortions do so out of fear and the stress of dealing with an unplanned pregnancy. God's mercy is always present for those who seek forgiveness and healing. And as Catholics we cannot simply object to abortions without providing helpful alternatives. 




