Using our gifts for the benefit of others and not just for our own interests and comfort.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

On the evening of December 13 last I gathered with my classmates to celebrate the anniversary of our ordination to the priesthood, which had occurred on December 14, 1985. Gathering as a class to celebrate that sacred day is something our class does every December since 1986. A toast is made, a meal is shared and many stories are told, not only about Ordination Day but also about the ministry we've enjoyed through the years.

Certainly there are many memories from that December 14 thirty-five years ago. The ordaining prelate, Archbishop John May, is discussed. We remember words or phrases from his homily. We recall many of the priests who concelebrated that Mass, along with the Vincentian priests who taught us. We talk about our families, remembering the five sets of parents who occupied the first pews. All but one have passed on to Eternal Life. We shudder at the memory of how cold it was that day - just above 0° - and we laugh at the very noticeable gaffes the organist made. It was a beautiful Mass, a wonderful day, long-awaited and grace-filled. It's memory always uplifts me.

It was a bit different day than another day I was at a church, March 18, 1956, the day of my baptism. I didn't walk in any procession that day; I was carried in. But not by my mother, mothers didn't travel so soon after delivering back then. My father was there and, obviously, my great uncle and my great aunt who served as godparents. I assume my mother's parents were there but nobody came from my father's side, being they lived across the Atlantic Ocean. I have no idea if other babies were baptized that day. I presume there were, as 1956 still remains the year for the most baptisms in the archdiocese and the church where I was baptized - St. Gregory - was in the middle of the exploding suburb of St. Ann. My own family had moved there just a month before the baptism. As a priest I met the priest who baptized me. He didn't seem too impressed.

Two wonderful days - one in a full Cathedral, one in a mostly empty church. One with an archbishop, one with a simple priest. One with beaming parents, one with a mother not even present. Once with a video and hundreds of photos, one with no pictures at all. One day I'll never forget, one day I can't remember.

Yet the late accomplished Scripture scholar Fr. Raymond Brown said, "The day when a person is baptized is more important than the day when a person is ordained priest and bishop." I agree with that. I would add that the baptismal day also is greater than any wedding day. It is the day that we begin to share in the glory of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It is the day we are incorporated into the Body of Christ, the Church. It is the day we become co-heirs with Christ to the life of grace and the day we become by adoption children of the Father and brothers and sisters of one another. And as it was for Jesus on coming out of the water, our Baptism day is a day when with us the Father is well pleased. We become His beloved. It's a fantastic day, and it should be remembered and celebrated.

So, do you know the date of your baptism? Do you celebrate the grace you received that day? Pray for your parents and godparents? Go through any photos or videos?

Or, are you ignorant of your baptismal date? Do nothing to let it make a sacred impression on you?

Having been baptized as an adult, I'm sure Jesus had fond and spiritual memories of his baptism. I'm sure it was for Jesus a source of joy, encouragement, and power. The sound of the Father's voice ringing in his ears must have provided Jesus great confidence. Remembering our baptism will do the same for us.

Today brings to a conclusion the Season of Christmas. Again I want to thank all those who made our church and our Liturgy so beautiful. Your music, your song, and your decorations enabled all of us to be in a place where we grew closer to the Christ Child. Thank you.

May God bless all of you.




