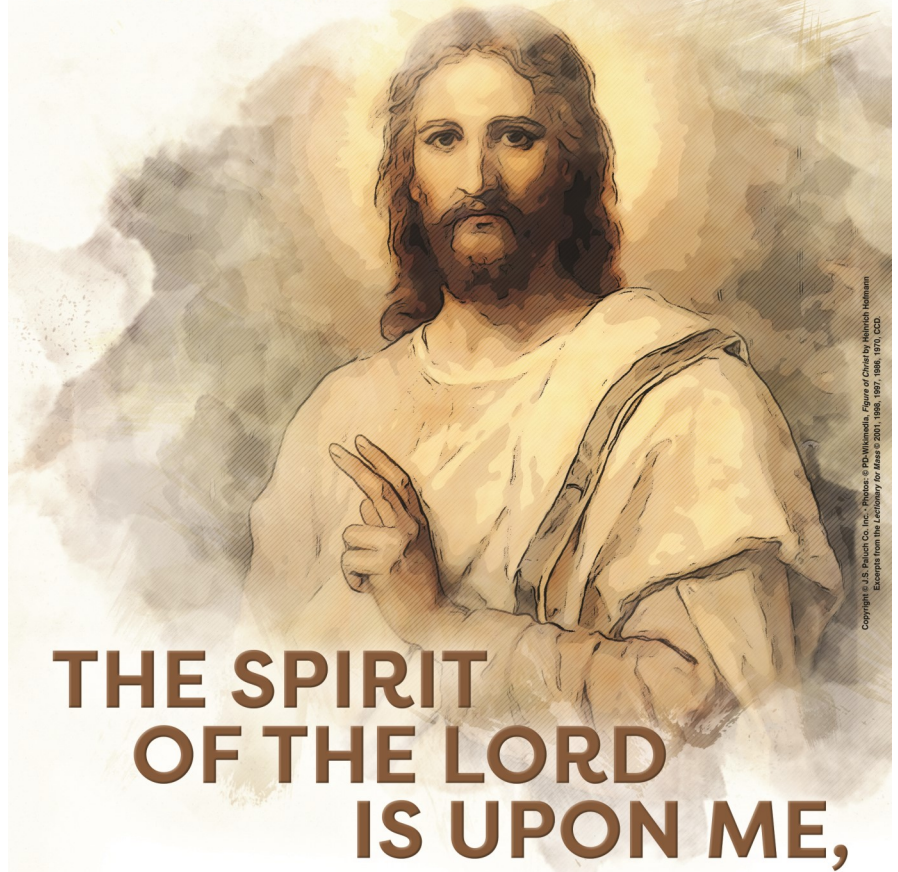

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Mother Theresa once said: “I feel the greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion because it is a war against the child, a direct killing of the innocent child, murder by the mother herself. And if we accept that a mother can kill even her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another? ... By abortion, the mother does not learn to love, but kills even her own child to solve her own problems. And by abortion, the father is told that he does not have to take any responsibility at all for the child he has brought to the world. The father is likely to put other women in the same trouble. So one abortion just leads to more abortion . Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love but to use violence to get what you want. This is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion.”

Powerful words from a great saint. Likewise powerful words were spoken once by Frederica Mathews-Green, former vice-president of Feminists for Life of America, when she said, “Abortion is not a sign women are free, but a sign that they are desperate.” How true! Thankfully, in our nation and in our parish there are people, some of them still teenagers, who believe in the Pro-Life cause and are now travelling back from Washington, D.C. where they backed up their beliefs by participating in the Pro-Life March. We can be thankful to God for inspiring through the Holy Spirit so many committed individuals. For Mother Teresa had it right and, sadly, we live in a country where too many people solve their problems by using violence, whether it be those who use the abortion industry or those who solve their problems by drive-by shootings. We cannot condemn the latter unless we condemn the former. It baffles me that so many, particularly in the political sphere, rail against the violent crime in our streets while at the same time applaud the fact that abortion is legal and, by golly, they will fight vehemently to keep it so should the Supreme Court overturn Roe V. Wade! Sad thinking.

Jesus in today’s Gospel makes a pledge that he has come to protect and uplift the weakest of society. In his time, that would be the poor, the captives, the blind and the oppressed. This pledge is rooted in Sacred Scripture and driven by the Holy Spirit. It is not an empty promise and Jesus will not renege on it; it will be fulfilled.

In our times, I am sure that Jesus would include the unborn. How could he not? How could Jesus ever think that the Father, who created all things through the Son, would not want the created child to be born into this world? Not want the child to feel the warmth of the sun? Dive into a refreshing pool? Make a snowball? Or experience the powerful beauty of another’s love? It’s ridiculous to think God would want violence to be used so that we could live any way we want.

Thus, we send parishioners to march for Life. We offer prayers for the end of abortion. We pray, too, for those who have had or helped procure an abortion. Our Catholic Church has many resources to help those pained by this scourge. God’s love is there for all of us, even when we sin.

That love of God makes sure that we are not a desperate people. That love links us to Christ and Christ links us to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist links us to amazing power. No, desperation is not our calling; Life, from God, with God, for God, is.

Blood is amazing stuff. Did you know that adults have approximately 16 pints of blood in their body at any given time? One collection unit of blood is about 1 pint. It takes roughly 14 hours for your body to replace a donated pint of blood. In the U.S. alone, 41,000 units of blood are used each day. Only about 5% of healthy Americans donate blood. Multiple donations account for over 80% of the blood used for transfusions.

There is no substitute for blood.

You have the power to help people you may not even know. All it takes is for you to roll up your sleeve and donate a pint of blood. Remember, whole blood and blood products such as platelets can't be manufactured; they can only be given freely through the compassionate generosity of donors.
