

Notice the order of events in the Magi's visit. First, they knelt before Jesus and prayed to Him. Then they presented Him with their gifts. We, too, must take time to pray before we present our gifts to the Lord. We never know what God may be asking us to share!

#### FROM OUR PASTOR

#### Dear Parishioners,

The old monk was teaching the novices of the monastery. He inquired, "How can we determine the hour of dawn, when the night ends and the day begins?"

A hand shot up and the young monk stated confidently, "When from a distance you can distinguish between a dog and a sheep."

"Nope," answered the priest.

"Is it when you can distinguish between a fig tree and a grapevine?" another novice wanted to know.

"No, it is not," Father said, and then continued, "It is when you can look into the face of a human being and you have enough light in you to recognize a person as your brother and sister. Until that moment it is night, and darkness is still with us.

Of course, the monks could have answered the Feast of the Epiphany. The star pierced the darkness and caught the attention of the Magi. With haste they set out on their journey, eager to pay homage. Arriving at Bethlehem, they presented their precious gifts. Overjoyed at what had happened, they gave evidence of the truth of Isaiah's words, "Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem. Your light has come .... Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance."

Thanks to this day, thanks to the presence of the Christ Child, we are not a people who stumble about as if we're trying to tell the difference between a dog and a sheep. We now know that this Child was born for all people, for Jew and Gentile, and for people then and people now. This Child will teach us how to love one another as He loves us. Jesus will insist that we serve one another as he serves us and he will command that His light shines as if from the housetop; there can be no confusion about when it is day and when it is night. Like the star shining in the darkness, the light of Christ shines in us. What can we do but bow down and pay Christ homage?

The great composer Johann Sebastian Bach always placed two sets of letters on his musical manuscripts. At the beginning of the composition he penned "J.J." - that is, Jesu Juvet - "Jesus, help me." At the end of his work he wrote, "S.D.G." - that is Soli Dei Gloria, "To God alone be glory."

Perhaps this would be a good thing to write on a calendar or imprint in our mind as we begin the Year of Our Lord 2021. Certainly, considering all that happened in 2020, we could use the help of Jesus as we begin this year. Jesus is still in the lap of Mary as we celebrate Epiphany Sunday. But we know He grows up and we know He promises to be with us always. We need Jesus as we start 2021.

And using the strength and power that only Jesus can provide, and following like obedient sheep in the direction Jesus takes us during the next twelve months, we can be sure that we will insist that all that happens to you, we, our parish, our families, and our country will be for the glory of God alone. For that to happen, it will require our watchfulness, steadfastness and commitment to Jesus Christ. Then, as certainly as the Lord guaranteed that those Magi made it home safely, the Lord will bring us safely through the year 2021.

Happy New Year to all of you. May God bless you abundantly on each of the next 362 days.




