### FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

This Year of Our Lord 2022 is a special year for Queen of All Saints Parish. On July 15, 1972, founding pastor Fr. Thomas Davisson offered the first Mass for the newly-formed Oakville parish. The fifty years since then has seen the fruits of that first Mass, and the blessings of the thousands of Masses offered here since then, allow Queen of All Saints parishioners to do incredible things in the Name of Jesus Christ, aided by the prayers of Our Blessed Mother and all the Saints. This parish has educated thousands of children through the school and the Parish school of Religion. We have brought aid and comfort to the poor,

consolation and compassion to the grieving, skills and sportsmanship to the athlete, amazing grace and goodness through the sacraments, and, most important of all, praise and honor to God.

The parish has not been perfect at it, though, for as humans we have our faults and commit our sins. But from where I sit, having been part of this parish for just 2 1/2 of the 49 1/2 years, I believe God is pleased at what has been accomplished here. Such pleasure does not prompt us to relax; rather with a renewed resolve continue to serve the Lord and his people.

During this special year, then, our Fiftieth Anniversary Committee has planned events both spiritual and social. Therefore, mark your calendars for these dates:

<u>April 4-7</u>: This will be the time for a <u>Parish Mission</u>. We have invited back four priests once stationed here to lead us spiritually during the Season of Lent. Each priest will speak to the question Jesus once asked his Apostles, "Who do you say that I am?" The priests preparing to speak to us are:

April 4: Fr. Fonseca April 5: Fr. Vien April 6: Fr. Stanger April 7: Fr. Fallon

Please mark your calendars for this special week.

In July we will celebrate our fifty years with Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski. The archbishop will celebrate the Mass on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>July 30</u>, at 5:00 p.m. After Mass we have reserved the Royale Orleans Banquet Hall for a parish dinner. In addition to the meal, we are planning to have one of the former pastors speak and we'll show a video about Queen of All Saints. Information about reservations for that night will be forthcoming.

Finally, we have planned a night for families. Mark your calendar for <u>Saturday</u>, <u>August 27</u>. That evening we will provide burgers and brats and other food for everybody to enjoy. Then, the adults can sit and listen to live music while the children run around and get dirty. The evening will conclude with a fireworks display. It should be a lot of fun.

As mentioned, more details about all these special occasions will be made known as 2022 progresses. For now, keep those dates open and say your prayers, asking God to guide us and enrich us as we celebrate all God has done for us.

It is especially important to celebrate Queen of All Saints in 2022 because, frankly, in 2023 we don't know what this parish will look like, although it's a good bet it won't look like what is today. On January 25 Archbishop Rozanski announced a new initiative entitled "All Things New." Over the course of the next 16 months our archdiocese - and every parish in it - will be analyzed. Information about each parish will be gathered. Ideas about merging parishes will be floated. Allocation of priests will be discussed. "All things New" is not the final plan. It's a plan to make a plan, and whatever that plan will be the Archbishop will announce on Pentecost Sunday, 2023.

In March, each one of you will be asked to complete a survey about the future of the archdiocese. In the fall two meetings will be scheduled at every parish so parishioners may offer their thoughts. A lot will be happening and if you would like to receive emails about it then go to allthingsnew.archstl.org and submit your address. I, also, will keep you informed.

# Dynamic Catholic, Alive! - Love & Truth

In the first reading today we hear that God has called each of us to be a "prophet to the nations." This doesn't mean that we all need to leave the country to share the truth of the Gospel. We can do it right here in our own hometown, and God will be there by our side. Jesus confirms this in the Gospel. However, Jesus also warns us in the Gospel that we may not be accepted in our own "native place." Just as He didn't let that stop Him, He doesn't want it to stop us either. St. Paul gives us two important benchmarks to guide us and these are "Love and Truth." We must always share the truth of the Gospel with love and truth, because we can't have one without the other.


