If you thought you knew all of the facts surrounding the 1973 Supreme Court decision, you definitely need to see this film and learn how this case was really decided. Seeing this film now is so timely as the Supreme Court convenes their new session this week and will hear, among others, the arguments on the Mississippi law that may well affect the 1973 Roe v Wade decision.





**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
