

LISTENING SESSIONS HERE AT QAS

We all know the Church of today is not the same as it was 50 years ago and yet, in many ways, we still function out of the same model of evangelization used back then.

We may wonder what our parishes need to look like in order to effectively share the faith in a suitable and sustainable way with future generations.

All Things New needs your help to evaluate our effectiveness in proclaiming the Gospel and in identifying opportunities for renewal.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the Listening Sessions & how do I attend one at Queen of All Saints?

The Archdiocese will host two listening sessions here in the Queen of All Saints Cafeteria on November 8th & 10th from 6-8pm and, due to limited seating, anyone interested in attending one of these sessions should register at https://allthingsnew.archstl.org as soon as possible.

Each session, facilitated by volunteer parishioners from another parish, will present a pre-recorded message from Archbishop Rozanski and Fr. Chris Martin, his Vicar for Strategic Planning, with a general overview of All Things New and multiple DRAFT model options for our specific planning area.

There will be a brief time allotted for small group discussion and then some facilitated feedback from the larger assembly.

How can I prepare for my Listening Session?

The Archdiocese has created a Parish Workbook specifically for Queen of All Saints as a supplement to help prepare for Listening Sessions. It provides practical data from the Pastoral Planning Committee, validated by our Key Parish Leaders. This workbook offers you a chance to approach the Listening Session with a better understanding of the information which was used to formulate the DRAFT models for our region you will hear about.

Posted on *allthingsnew.archstl.org*, this information will be available for anyone to view.

What are the parishes in our region?

We are part of Planning Area 5 which includes 14 parishes: Assumption, Mary Mother of the Church, Queen of All Saints, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Andrew, St. Bernadette, St. Catherine Laboure, St. Elizabeth of Hungary, St. Justin Martyr, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Mark, St. Martin of Tours, St. Matthias, and St. Simon the Apostle.

What is a DRAFT model?

A DRAFT model is a proposed option for how parishes in our area could be structured. The models you will see are "unfinished" because they need the feedback and insight of the parish community which will then be presented to Archbishop Rozanski for his discernment.

Will we find out which parishes and/or schools will be closed at the Listening Sessions?

No - You will be presented with DRAFT models for our planning area which may show parish merger options but without exact details.

Though there is no exact date for when information about schools will be available, the goal is to make an announcement prior to re-enrollment for the 2023-24 Academic Year.

No decisions will be made about specific closures or mergers until after all the Listening Sessions & additional feed back is collated.

Do I have to attend both Listening Sessions?

The same information will be present at both of our Listening Sessions, so there is no need to attend both meetings.


What if I cannot attend one of our Listening Sessions?

After all the Listening Sessions in each parish of our region are held, the Archdiocese will make public the content online and offer another opportunity for parishioners to provide open-ended feedback through an online survey.

If I cannot make a Listening Session at our parish, can I go to another parish's Listening Session?

Because each Listening Session will have information unique to that particular parish, it would be best to attend one of your own parish's Listening Sessions.

The registration system has some latency issues when selecting the session. Please be patient and wait for the session to populate as the issues are trying to be resolved.




