


#### STEWARDSHIP EVENING WITH ARCHBISHOP



QAS Day Trip to Shrine of Our Lady of Miraculous Medals: Please have your entire family join us for a day trip to the historic National Shrine of Our Lady of Miraculous medals in Perryville, Missouri on Saturday, October 22nd. Parishioners can meet at QAS at 8:00 a.m. It is about an hour to the Shrine. Once we arrive, we will start with a Rosary Walk at approximately 9:30 a.m., and then have a guided tour of the historic grounds starting at 10:30 a.m. We will also view the grotto, and various Relics of the Shrine. A Mass will be held at 12:10 p.m., for anyone wishing to attend.

This beautiful shrine is a hidden gem, with impeccable grounds to walk. Saint Mary's of the Barrens was founded in 1818 by the Vincentian fathers. 


