FROM OUR SEMINARIAN JAKE BRAUN

The topic of this week's article is the Sacrament of Matrimony. While there is much to write about the cultural importance of this marriage in the context of a world that is increasingly anti-Catholic – which may yet be a future topic of discussion for this column – today, I will just lay out here the purpose and the effects of Holy Matrimony.

Marriage has an importance that is evident on the natural and the supernatural levels. Historically, the concept of marriage, which permeates all human societies, long predates the Christian culmination of Matrimony as a Sacrament. Divine Revelation gives the historical prevalence of marriage clearer meaning and origin by illustrating that man and woman have as part of their shared human nature the call to love one another in an exclusive, self-giving manner. While non-sacramental marriage was often sullied or even dissolved by sin, thanks to the fall of man, Christ's institution of Marriage as a Sacrament elevated what was already a natural societal good to the level of an indissoluble and efficacious sign of Jesus' own love for the Church. By doing so, he made the marriage bond a means for not only living one's life in fidelity with one's spouse, but also of growing closer to God together. To that end, there are some important graces and effects of Holy Matrimony that are bestowed on the couple.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church outlines two primary effects of the Sacrament of Matrimony. The first of these effects is the marriage bond itself. As stated by the Catechism, "The consent by which the spouses mutually give and receive one another is sealed by God himself," such that, "Authentic married love is caught up into divine love." This bond is "perpetual and exclusive" by its very nature, a reality that is irrevocable, and which the Church "does not have the power to contravene" precisely because it is a "covenant guaranteed by God's fidelity." To help the spouses live out this covenantal bond, Christ bestows upon them a special grace, "intended to perfect the couple's love and to strengthen their indissoluble unity," so that they may, "help one another to attain holiness in their married life and in welcoming and educating their children." This grace is a special encounter between the spouses and Jesus, "[who] dwells with them, gives them the strength to take up their crosses and so follow him, to rise again after they have fallen, to forgive one another, to bear one another's burdens, to be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ, and to love one another with supernatural, tender, and fruitful love." Holy Matrimony is an undeniably beautiful and inarguably important Sacrament. Faithfully living out this sacramental vocation is an act of defiance to a world so hellbent on destroying the sacredness of Marriage.

A Prayer for Thanksgiving

Loving God, we turn our hearts to you on this day for giving thanks, mindful of your many gifts.

For each one, we are grateful. For each one, we are blessed. For each one we are opened to the abundance of your love.

May this Thanksgiving Day offer a reminder to be generous with others, as you are with us..




Pro Life Christmas cards

Every person deserves to feel **Secure**, to be **Warm** and to have **HOPE!**


This year has been an unusually challenging year, that's for sure. One thing that has not changed, though, is the need for warm blankets for our homeless neighbors in downtown St. Louis.

The finished blankets or fleece donations can either be dropped off at the QAS Rectory during business hours, dropped off at 2793 Brandenberg Lane, or picked up from your house prior to Sunday, November 29. You can also drop off your finished blankets on November 29 at the QAS Cafeteria between 11 am and 1 pm.

These donated blankets will then be delivered to St. Patrick's Center where we know they will be greatly appreciated and immediately handed out to those in need of warmth. These blankets give the homeless physical and emotional warmth; they are a tangible sign of hope and love from people who care.


