### FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

The Emperor of France, Napoleon Bonaparte, was reviewing his troops in Paris when, in giving an order, he thoughtlessly dropped the bridle upon his horse's neck. The animal instantly set off at a gallop, and the Emperor was obliged to cling to the saddle, holding on for dear life.

So many soldiers were present and all of them looked on with a combination of shock and confusion - all but one. Just one soldier moved to help, a new recruit, a lowly private. He alone anticipated where the horse was going and courageously he

stepped into the horse's way. With skill he seized the bridle and brought the horse to a stop. Humbly and respectfully, he handed the bridle to the Emperor.

"Much obliged to you, Captain," said Napoleon, instantly making the new recruit an officer. Overwhelmed, yet appreciative of the Emperor's meaning, the young man saluted, and asked, "Of which regiment, sire?" Napoleon, still in a gracious mood, responded, "Of my guards." The Emperor then continued his inspection.

The new Captain laid down his gun, and rather than return to his own unit, confidently marched toward a group of officers. Shocked at the boldness of one wearing the uniform of a private, a General ordered him to halt and firmly inquired of the soldier, "Just what do you think you're doing here?" The answer came, "I am the Captain of the Guards." The General chuckled, "Are you mad? Are you sick? Do you expect me to believe you?" The new Captain only pointed at Emperor Napoleon. "He told me I was." The General looked at the Emperor, who nodded approvingly, and then begged the Captain's pardon. The Emperor's word was enough.

It has been said, if we thus took God at his word, how different our world would be.

A different life than what he expected was waiting for Joseph when he woke up from his dream. That planned wedding with its lengthy reception? - that wasn't happening now. That quiet life in Nazareth with his beautiful young bride? Not yet. That hope of fathering children and raising them? Yes, but God's Son, not yours. Everything for Joseph changed in a hurry.

Not, however, his trust in God. Not his belief that God's plans were best and that God's will must be done. Uncertainty surrounded Joseph, "what the heck is happening here?" But he would remain faithful. A nod of approval from the angel of the Lord was all it took. Joseph would take Mary into his home and our world is different because he did.

Being, as the Gospel tells us, a righteous man, Joseph already was aware of God's great love before he went to bed that night. That God's love would embrace him in an entirely unexpected way was not in his plans, but Joseph would certainly rely on that love as he obeyed the angel's order. God's love will do that to people.

A boy once found a turtle and he wanted to examine the creature closely. As he began, the turtle pulled in his head and closed its shell like a vice. The boy was frustrated and he picked up a screwdriver to try and open the shell.

The boy's father saw this and remarked, "No, that's not what you do. In fact, if you keep using that screwdriver you may hurt, or worse, kill the turtle."

The man took the turtle from his son and asked the boy to follow him inside. Once in the house, he placed the turtle near the fireplace. It took only a few minutes for the warmth of the fire to force the turtle to push out his head, stretch out his legs and begin to crawl. "Turtles are like that," said the father, "and people too. You can't force them into anything. But if you first warm them up with special love, more than likely they will do what you want them to do."

This Fourth week of Advent is our time to be aware of the nodding approval of God, who calls us to imitate the obedience of St. Joseph. This is our time to appreciate the beauty and warmth present in the Christ Child, who summons us to follow him. May the beauty of that love inspire us to do what the Lord wants us to do.




